Thank you for joining my 'Happy Everything' Sew along to make a Sampler quilt using blocks from my Holiday Celebrations book, we are going to have so much fun!

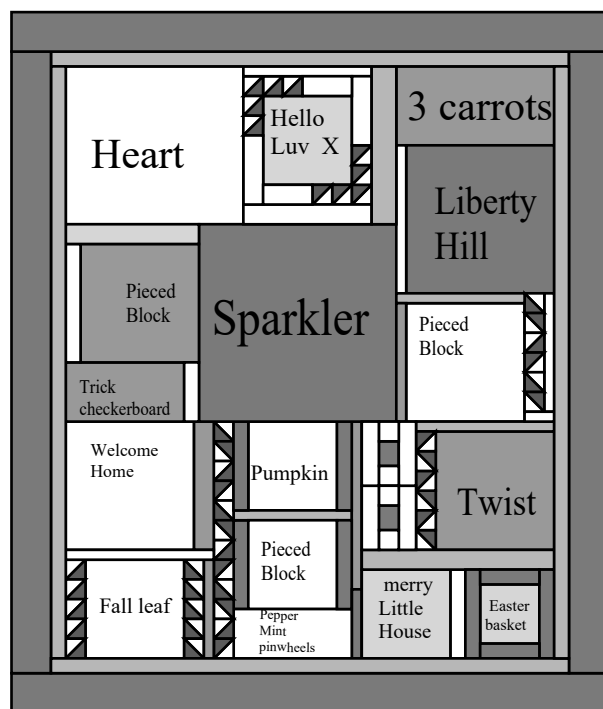
Dates: Oct 4, 2021 to Feb 28, 2022

I encourage you to use fabric you Own for the blocks and sashing. Watch my video on fabric selecting.

Then add to that background fabric That works, solids are a great value. Add to this fabrics for the sashings, Inner border, and outer border

Supply List

- My Holiday Celebrations Book
- 2 1/2 Yards Background (you may use less Depending on how you make your blocks)
- 20 or more fat quarters for the Blocks. More will give you variety. I'm working from my stash - watch my videos
- 6 or more fat quarters for Sashings - pick a Unifying color scheme. Watch my videos
- 1 yard Inner border and Binding
- 2 yards Outer border
- 5 1/2 yards Backing

Inner Borders

Cut 2 side inner borders 2" x 60.5" sew to center

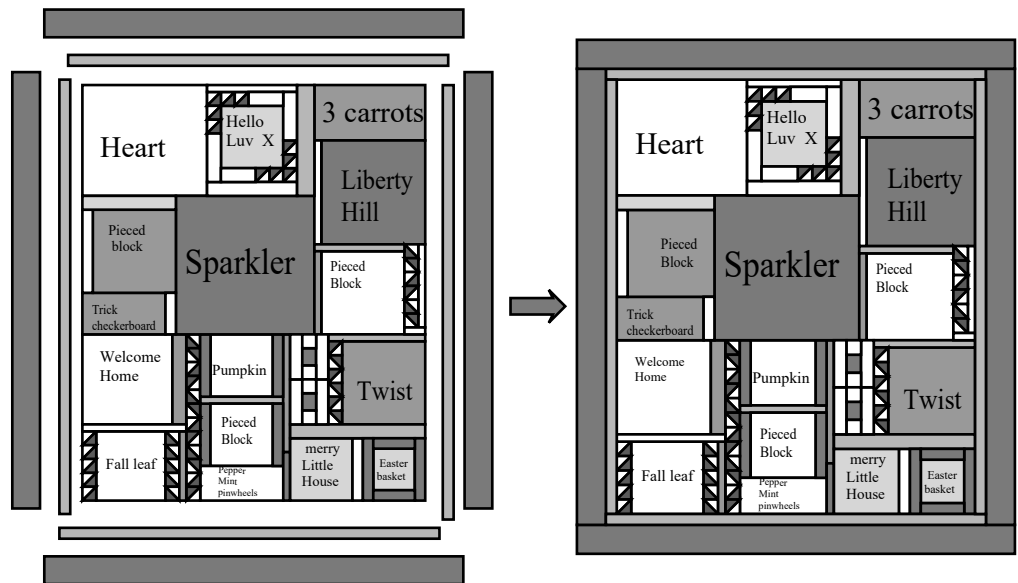
Cut 1 top and 1 bottom inner borders 2" x 53" sew to center

Outer Borders

Cut 2 side outer borders 4.5" x 61" sew to center

Cut 1 top and 1 bottom outer borders 4.5" x 63.5" sew to center

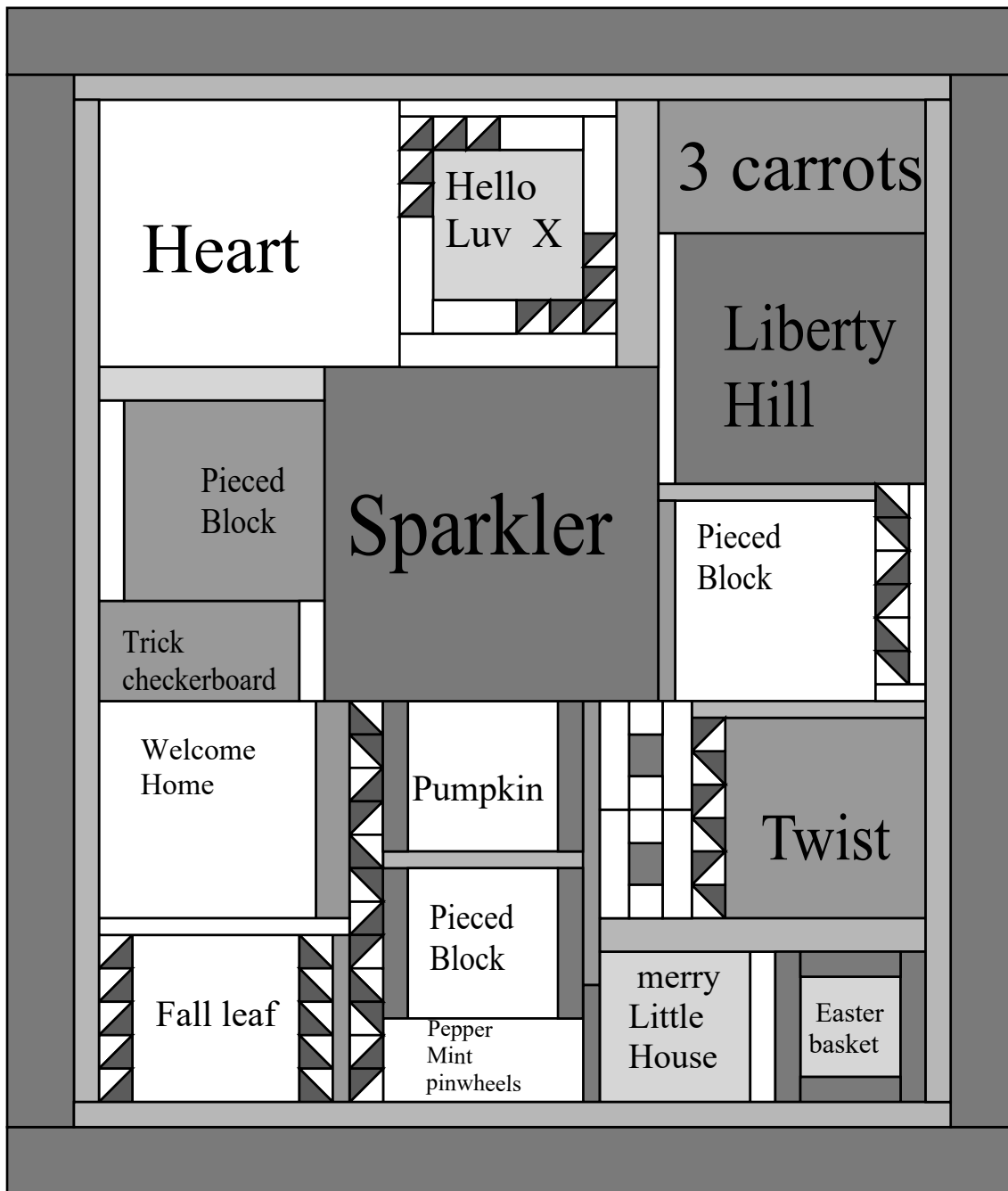

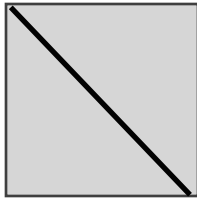

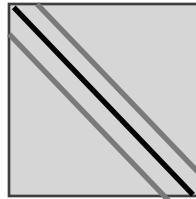
Half Square Triangles Tutorial

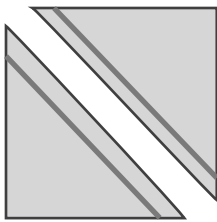
Step 1

- Draw a line on the back of all the lighter squares



Step 2

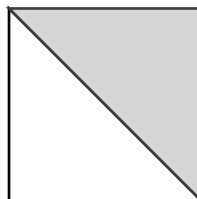
- Layer the 2 squares
- Sew a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam on both Sides of the drawn line



Step 3

Cut on the drawn Line for 2 HST

Step 4



-Trim squares to size needed using a square ruler with a diagonal line placed on the Seam.
