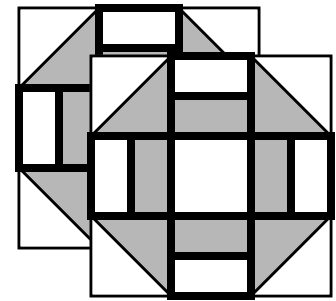

Cutting & Sewing For 2 blocks

Light Fabric

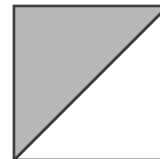
- Cut 4 squares 3" x 3" for HST (Half square Triangles)
- Cut 2 strip 1.5" x 11"
- Cut 2 square 2.5" x 2.5"

Dark Fabric

- Cut 4 squares 3" x 3" for HST (Half square Triangles)
- Cut 2 strip 1.5" x 11"

Directions

- 1) Sew a light 3" squares and a dark 3" squares Using HST method on last page. Make 4 units - trim to 2.5" square

Directions

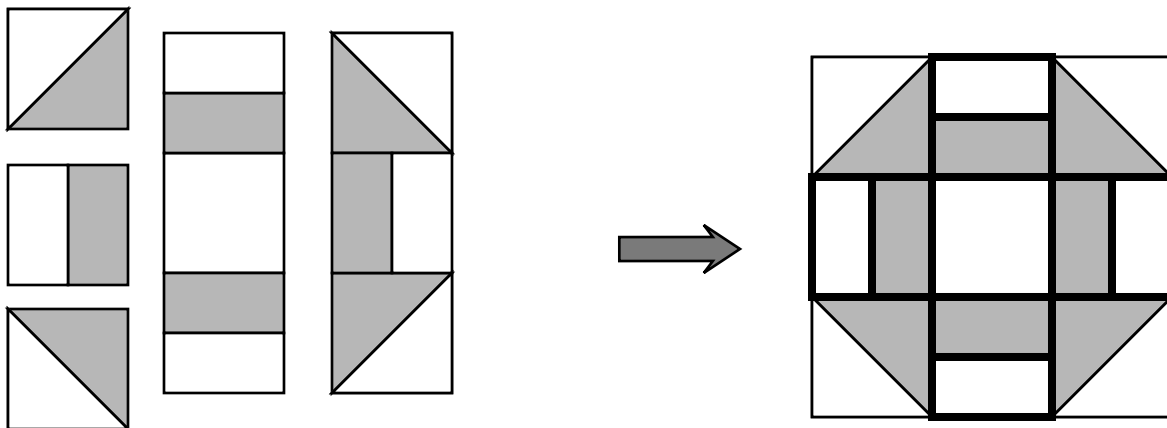
2) Sew a light 1.5" strip to a dark 1.5" strip
 Sub cut into 2.5" x 2.5" units
 Make 4 units

REPEAT to make
 The 2nd block



3) Following the diagram, sew the block using the 4 HST, the 4 units from step 2
 And the 2.5" square
 Measures to 6.5" x 6.5" square
 REPEAT to make the 2nd block

Make 2 blocks for your quilt

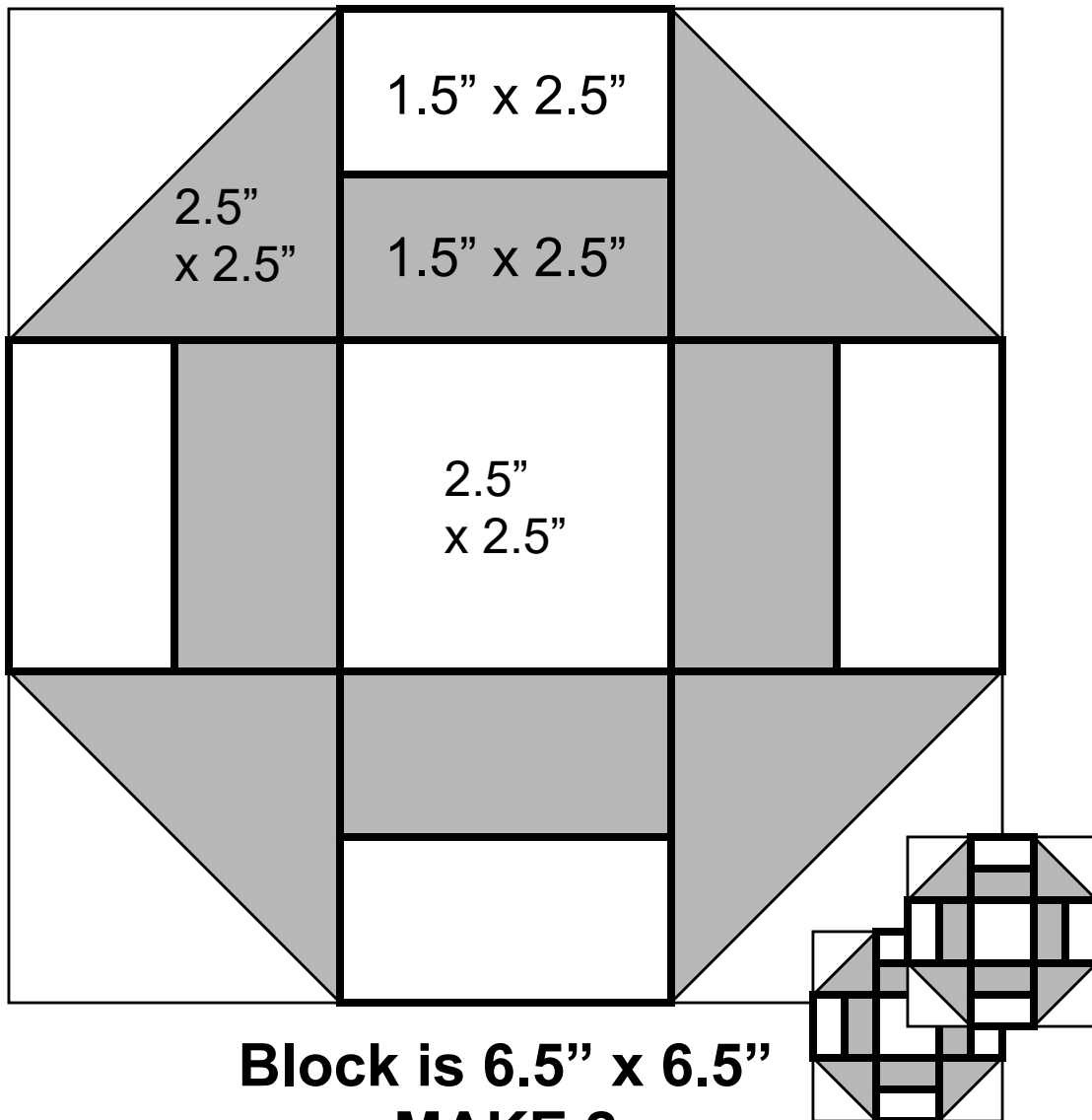

In the Quilt it is finished size 6" x 6"

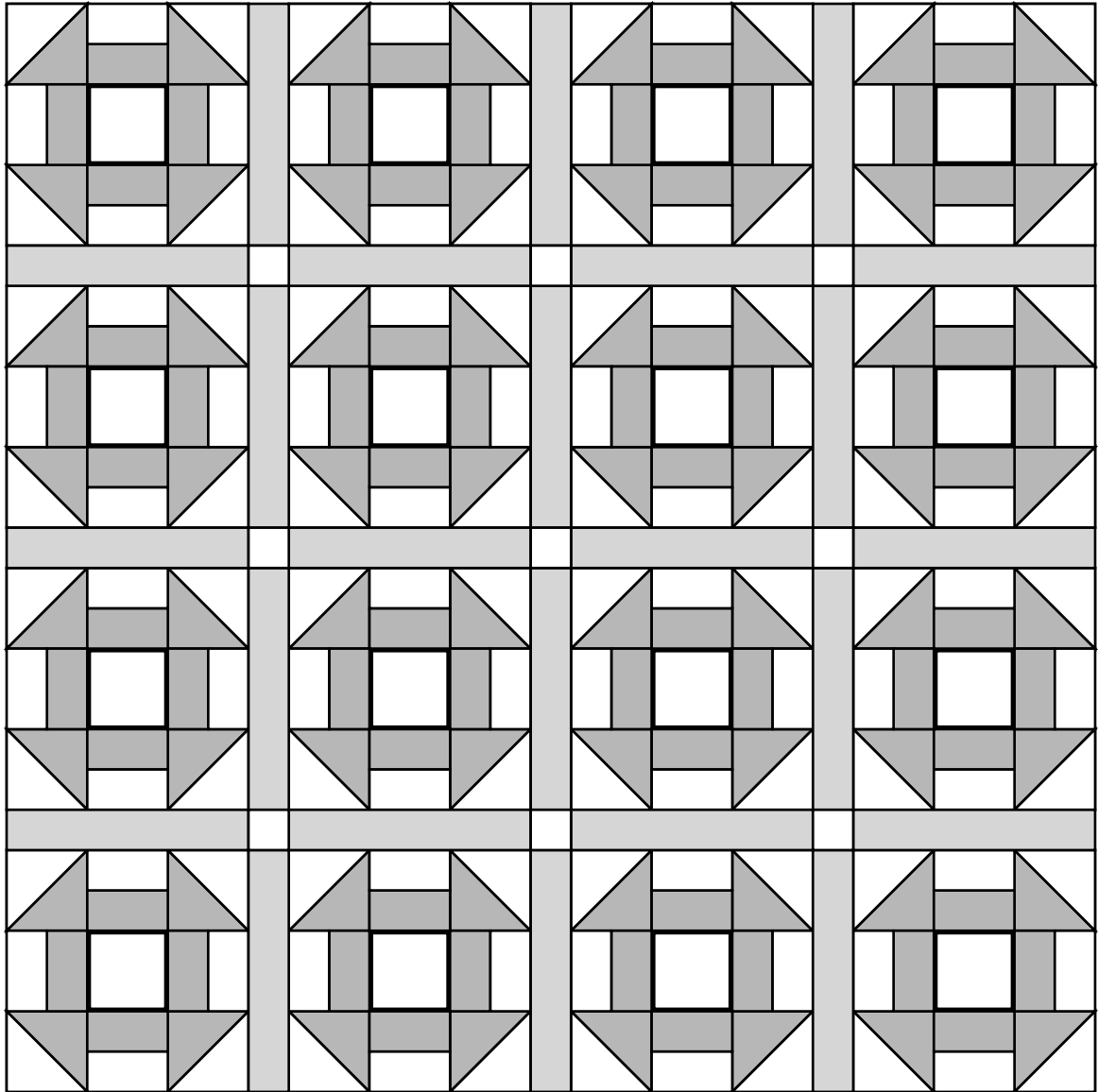

Block 12 – Long and Winding Road

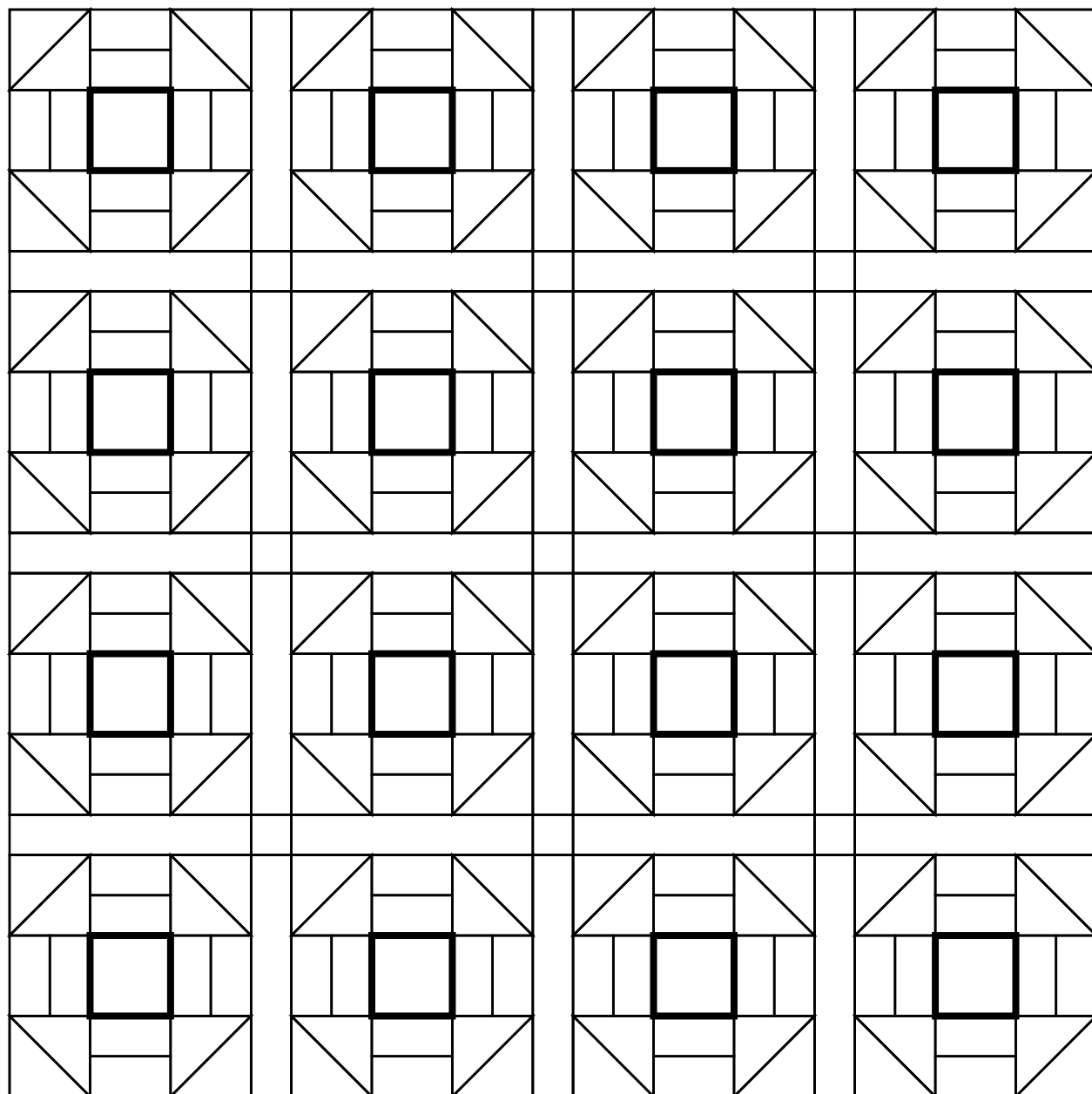
27.5" x 27.5" quilt

Cut 24 sashing 1.5" x 6.5"

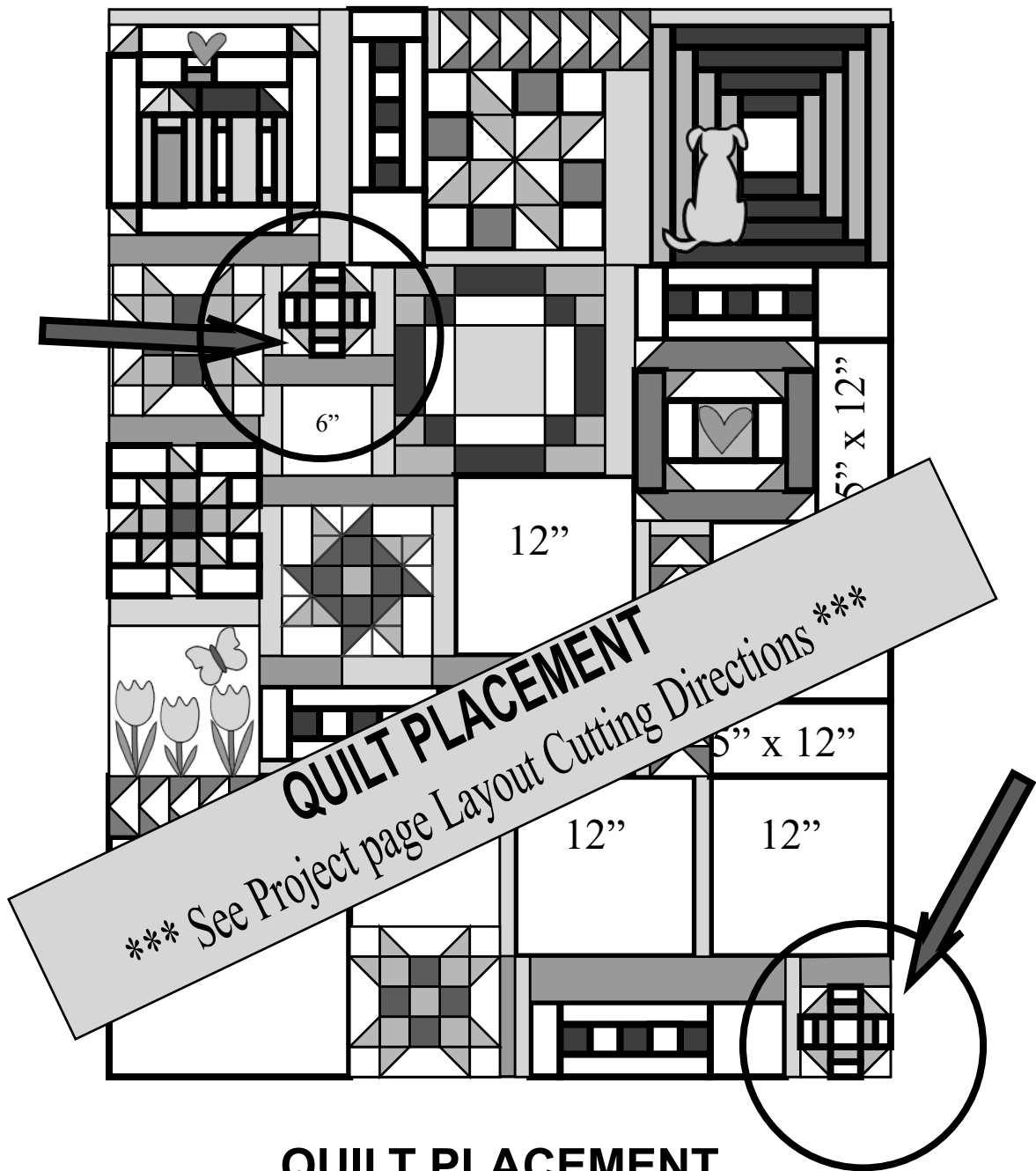
Cut 9 squares 1.5" x 1.5"

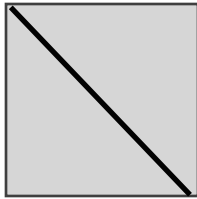

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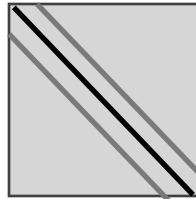

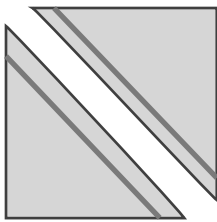
Step 1

- Draw a line on the back of all the lighter squares



Step 2

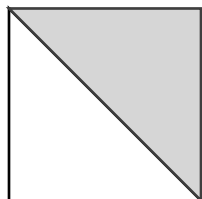
- Layer the 2 squares
- Sew a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam on both Sides of the drawn line



Step 3

Cut on the drawn Line for 2 HST

Step 4



-Trim squares to size needed using a square ruler with a diagonal line placed on the Seam.
