Might it be used as phone book with cards and numbers you need to reference?

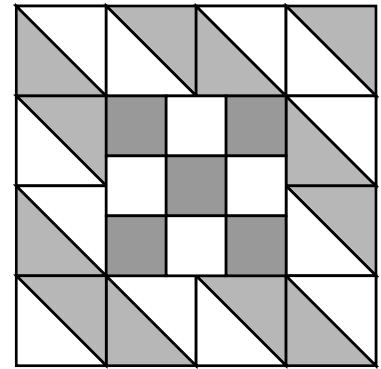
Or do you have a clear and free Fridge with nothing stuck on it?

Finished size 12" x 12"

Cutting & Sewing

Light Fabric - you could use multiple Fabrics

- Cut 6 squares 4" x 4" for HST (Half square Triangles)
- Cut 4 squares 2.5" x 2.5"

Medium Fabric

- Cut 6 squares 4" x 4" for HST (Half square Triangles)

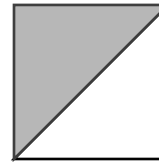
Dark Fabric

- Cut 5 squares 2.5" x 2.5"

Directions

1) Sew a light 4" square and a medium 4" Square using the HST method on last page.

trim to 3.5" square
Make 12 units

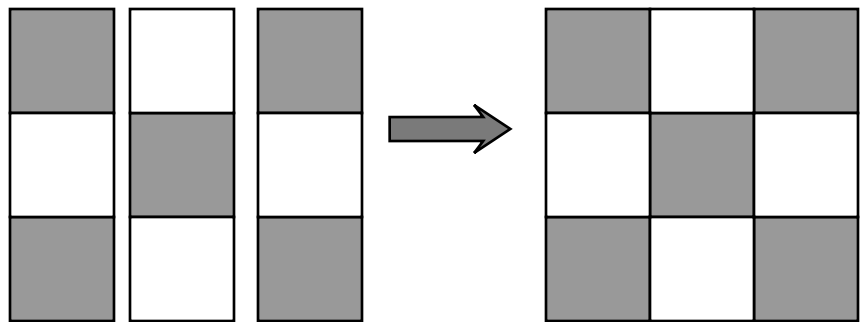

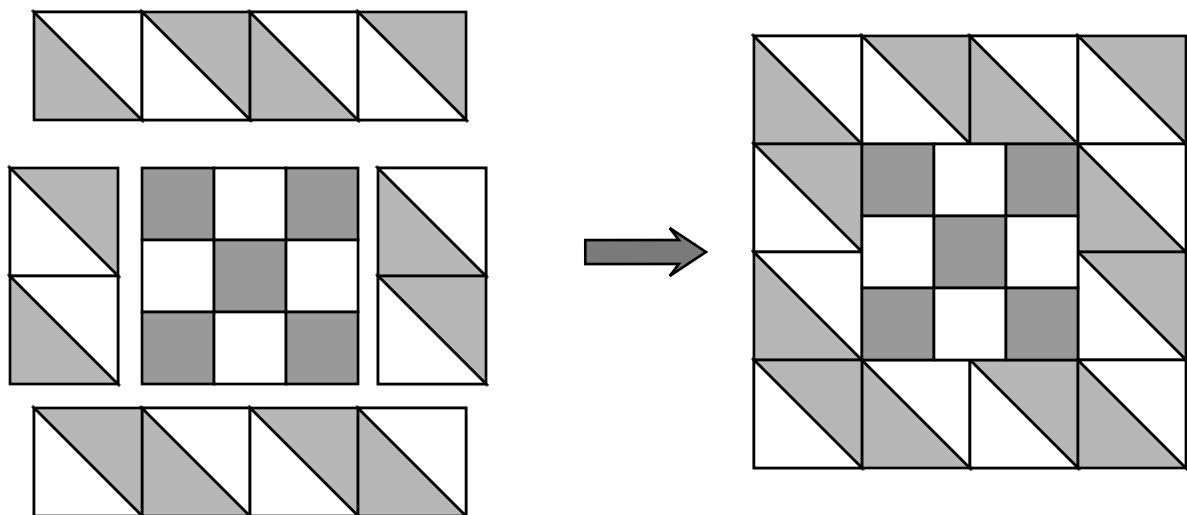

Directions

2) Following the diagram sew the 9-patch block using 5 of the dark 2.5" squares and 4 of the light 2.5" squares
 Measures 6.5" x 6.5"
 Make 1



3) Following the diagram, sew the block using the all the HST and the 9-patch unit from above
 Measures to 12.5" x 12.5"
 Make 1

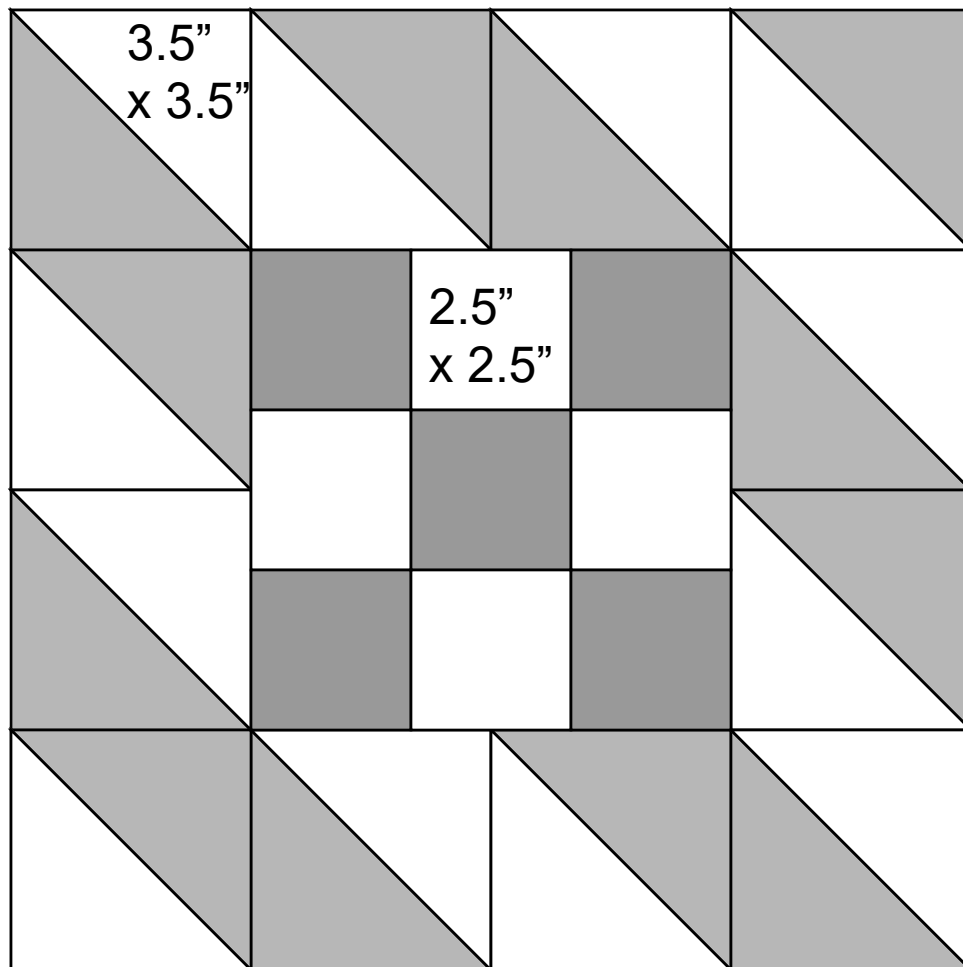

In the Quilt it is finished size 12" x 12"

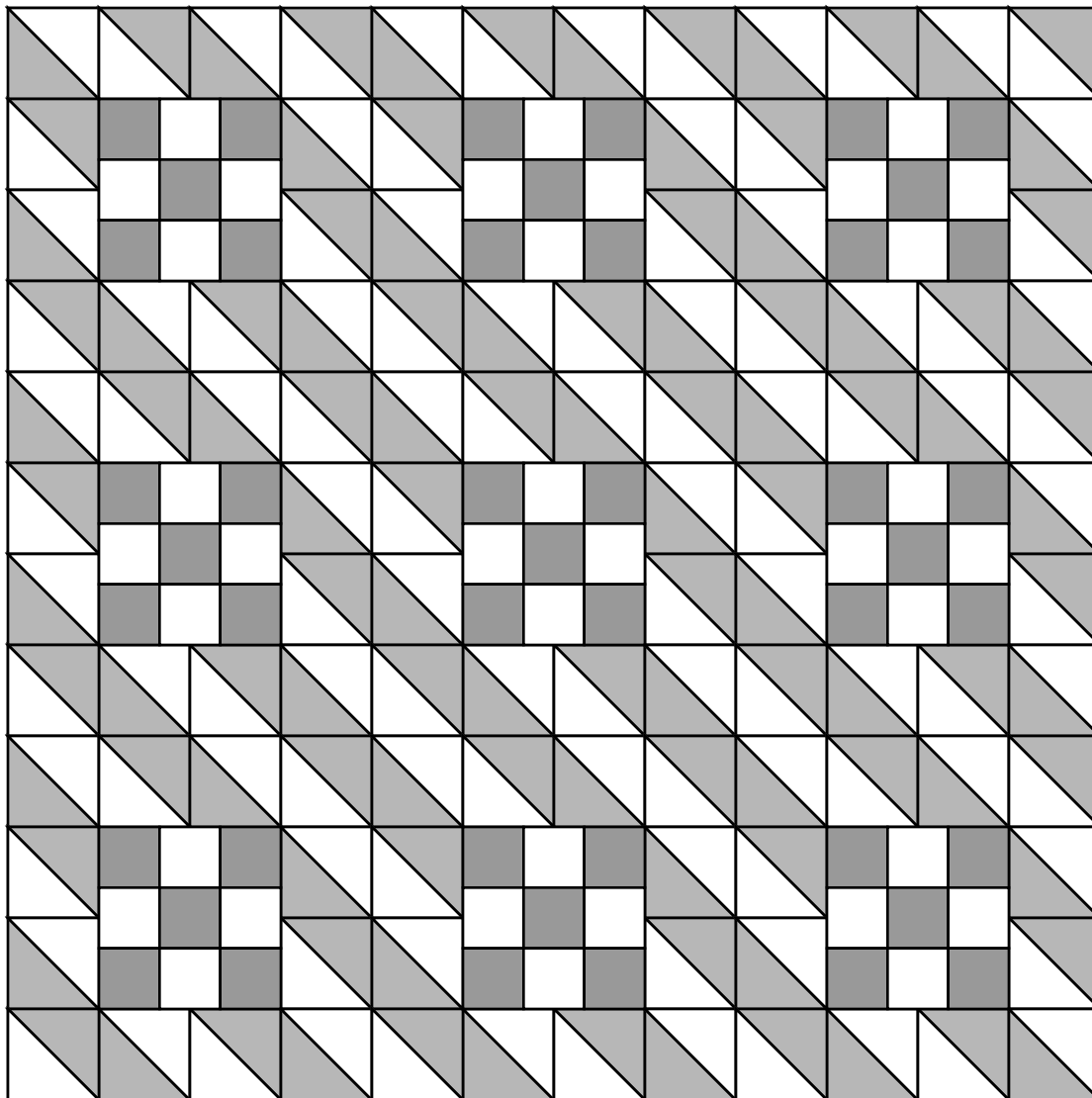

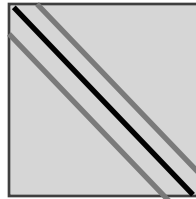
Half Square Triangles Tutorial

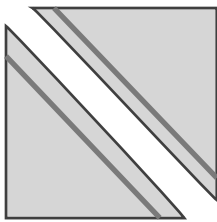
Step 1

- Draw a line on the back of all the lighter squares



Step 2

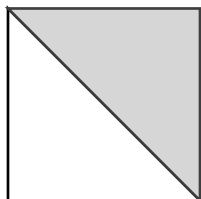
- Layer the 2 squares
- Sew a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam on both Sides of the drawn line



Step 3

Cut on the drawn Line for 2 HST

Step 4



-Trim squares to size needed using a square ruler with a diagonal line placed on the Seam.
