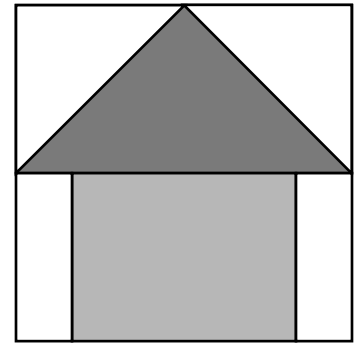

Finished size 6" x 6"

Cutting Directions

Background

- Cut 2 squares 3.5" x 3.5"
- Cut 2 strips 1.5" x 3.5"

Roof

- Cut 1 rectangle 3.5" x 6.5"

House

- Cut 1 rectangle 3.5" x 4.5"

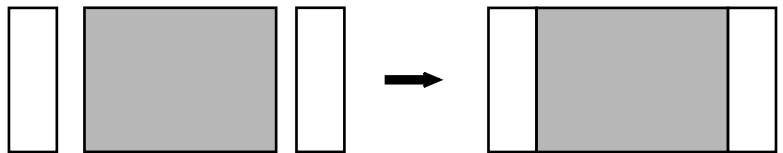
**TIP = On the cutting page
I give you an option for a door**

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Directions House section

- 1) Sew the 1.5" x 3.5" background strips to the sides Of the 3.5" x 4.5" house rectangle.
Measure 3.5" x 6.5"
Make 1

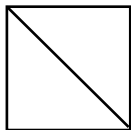

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Directions Roof`

- 1) Draw a diagonal line on each 3.5" background squares
 Make 2

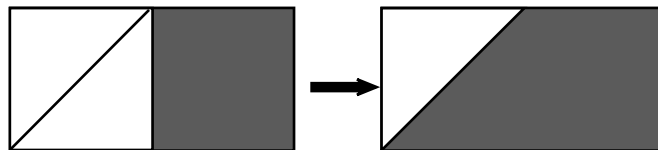


Step (2)

- 1) Following the diagram, Place a background square on 3.5" x 6.5" roof rectangle
 2) Sew on the line.
 3) Flip over and press, check the back to be sure it matches up to the rectangle
 4) Trim away the excess corner fabric behind the triangle. Leave a 1/4" seam.

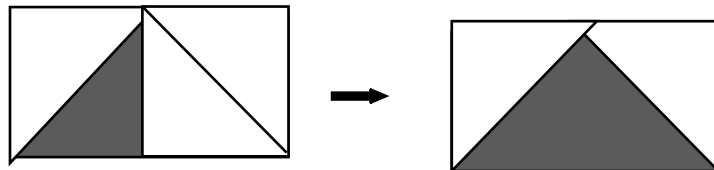
Make 1

Measures 3.5" x 6.5"



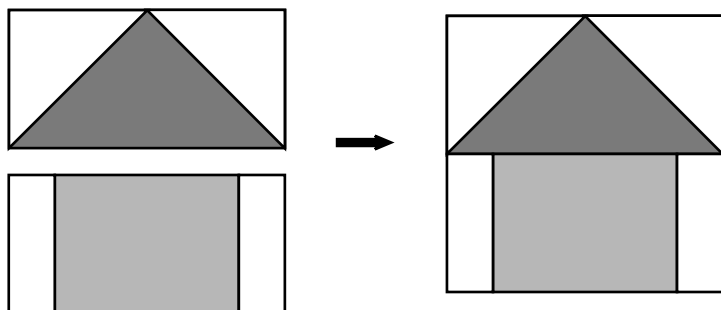
- 3) Following the diagram, repeat step 2 for the second square to make the flying geese
 Make 1

Measures 3.5" x 6.5"



- 4) Sew the roof unit to the house unit
 Make 1

Measures 6.5" x 6.5"

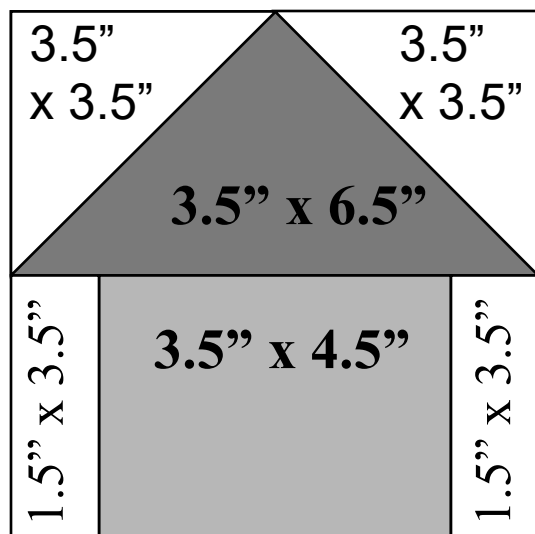


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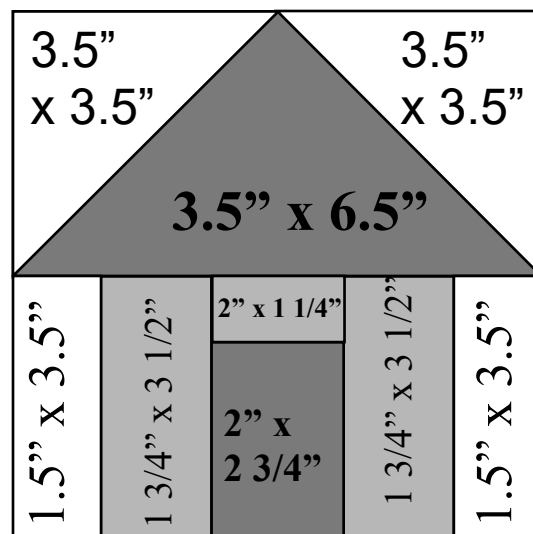

MAKE 1 block using either the house with the door OR without a door, your choice

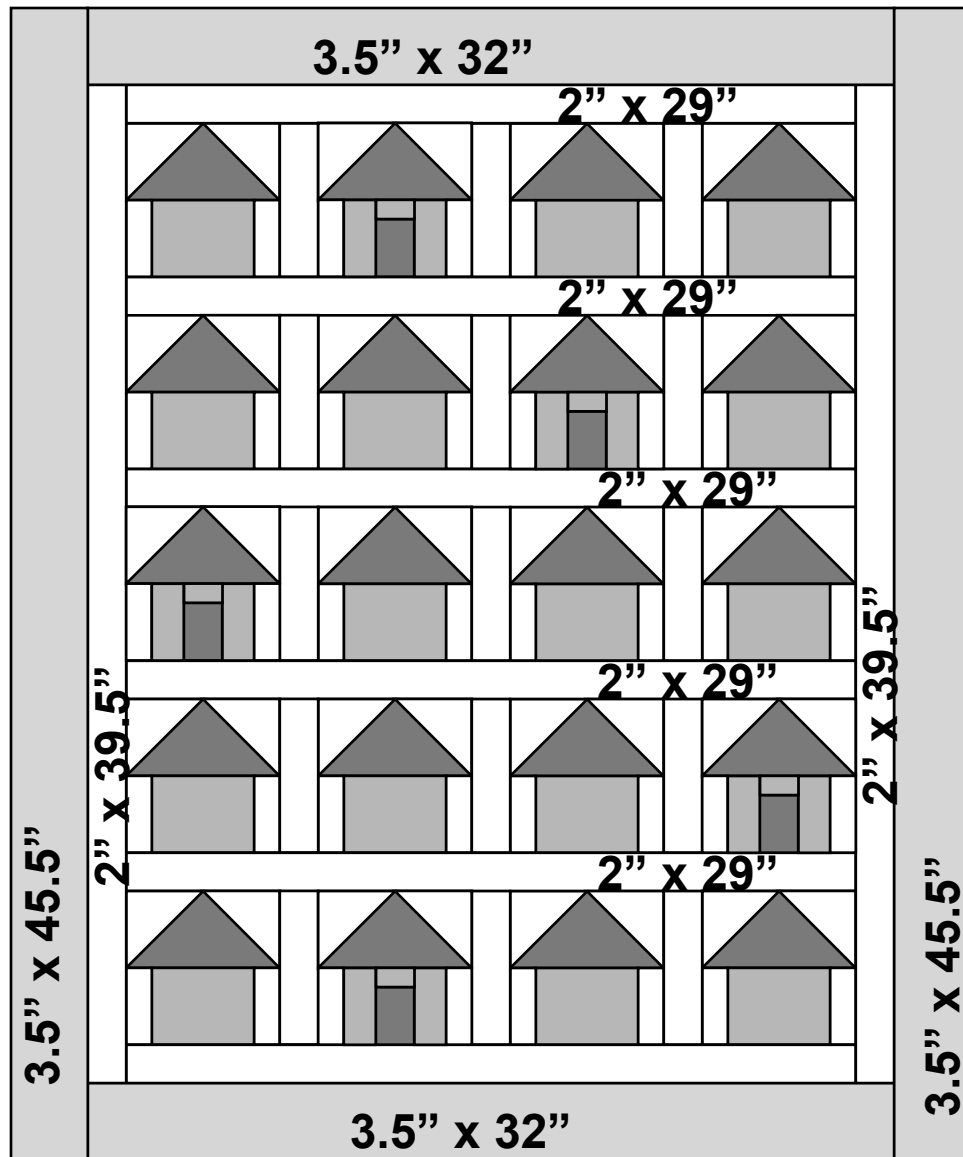
TIP: make one for your quilt label!

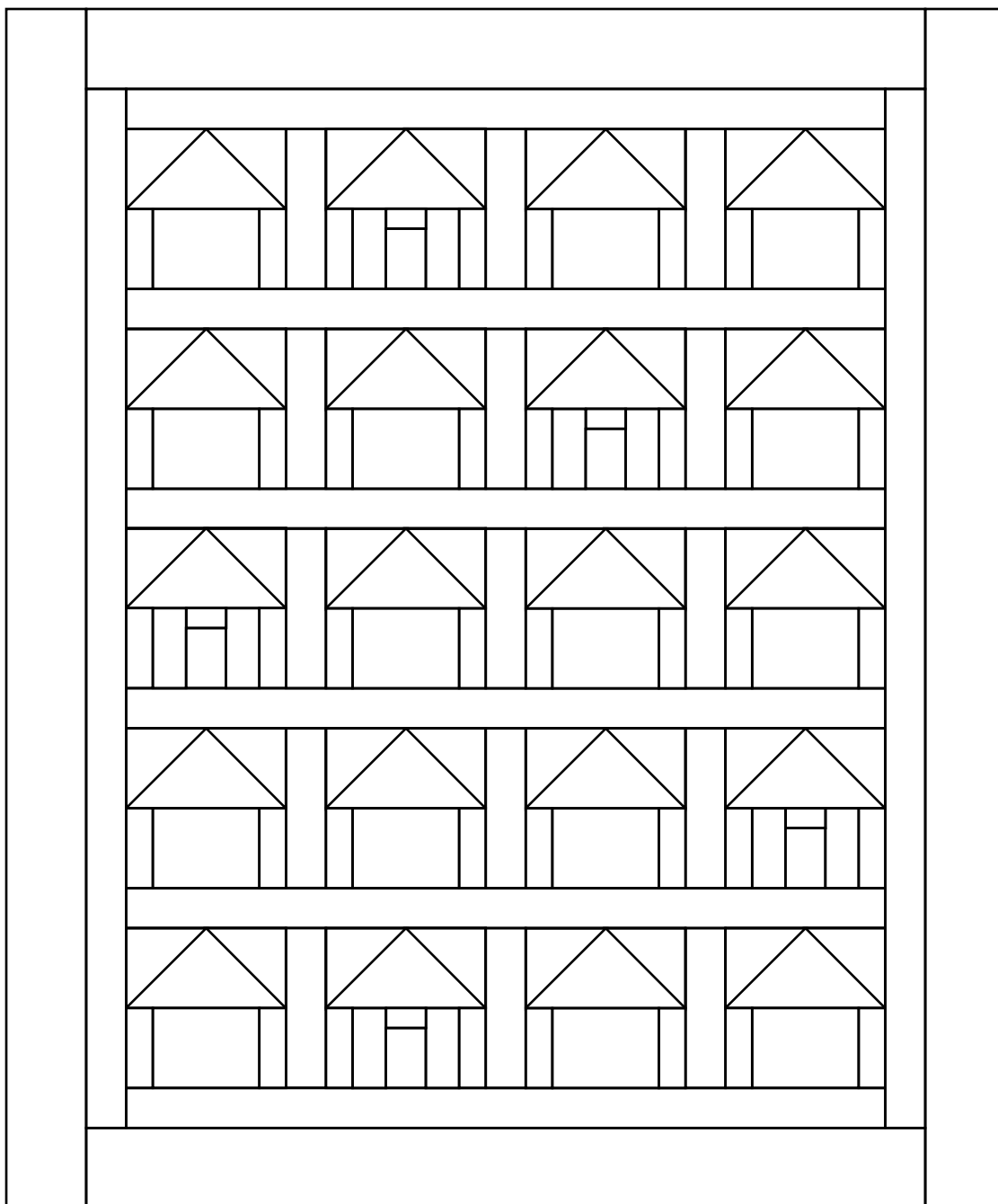

Cut 15 strips for between houses 2" x 6.5"

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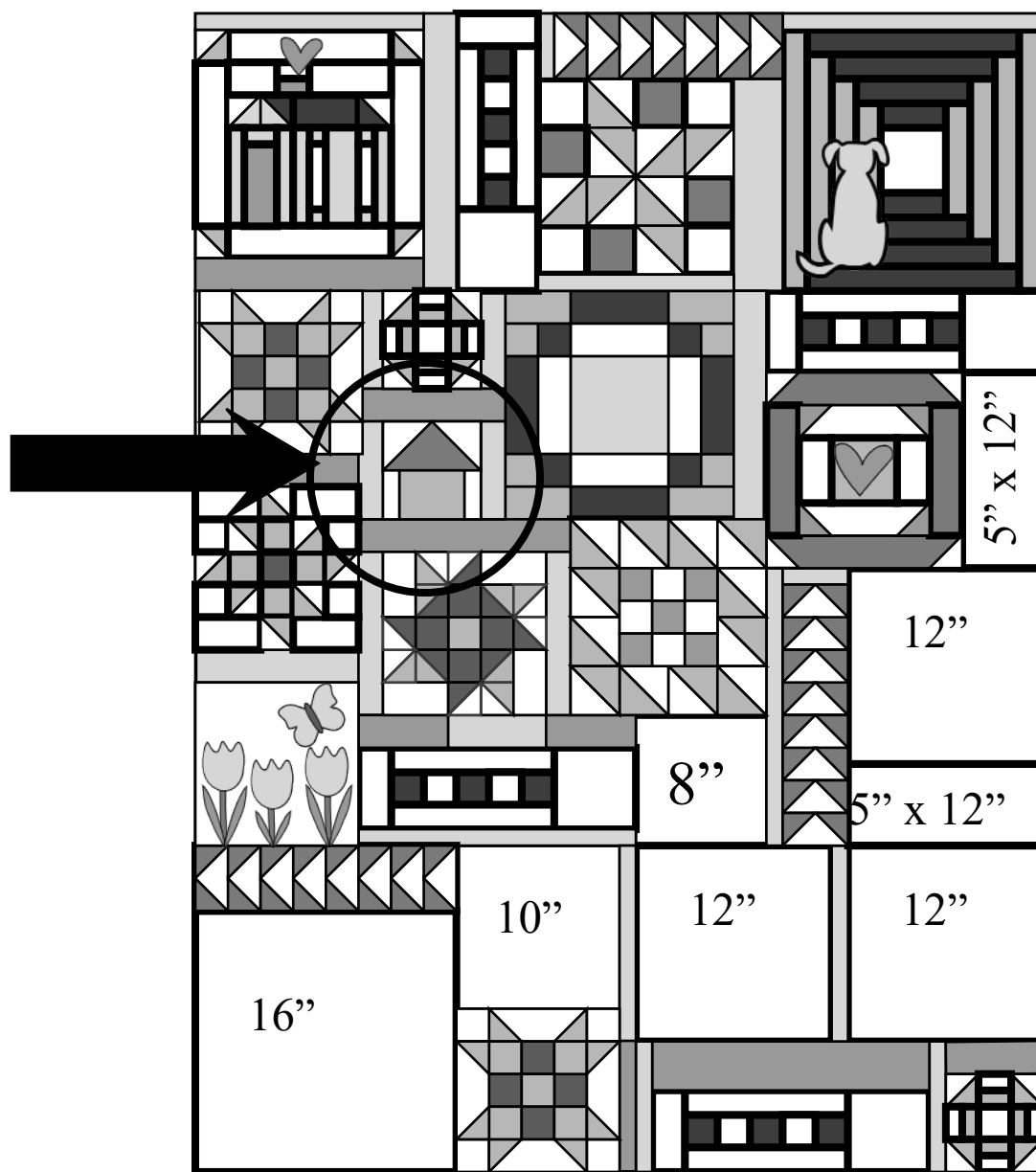
