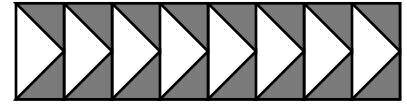
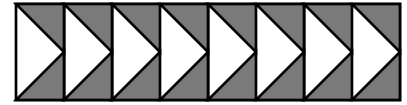
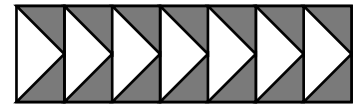

Background fabrics

NOTE: you could make this a Scrappy background with a variety Of fabrics

– Cut 23 strips 2.5" x 4.5"

Dark fabrics

– Cut 46 square 2.5" x 2.5"

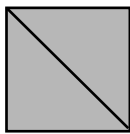

Directions Flying Geese Units

- 1) Draw a diagonal line on each 2" dark squares
Make 46

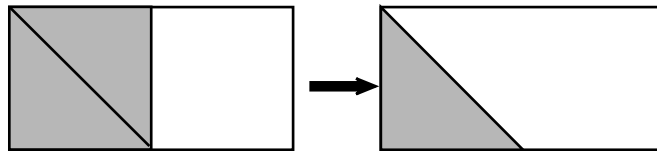


Step (2)

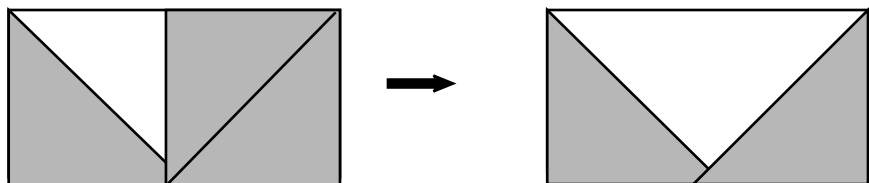
- 1) Following the diagram, Place a dark square on 2.5" x 4.5" background rectangle
- 2) Sew on the line.
- 3) Flip over and press, check the back to be sure it matches up to the rectangle
- 4) Trim away the excess corner fabric behind the triangle. Leave a 1/4" seam.

Make 23

Measures 2.5" x 4.5"



- 3) Following the diagram, repeat step 2 for the second square to make the flying geese
Make 23
Measures 2.5" x 4.5"

Measures 4.5" x 14.5"

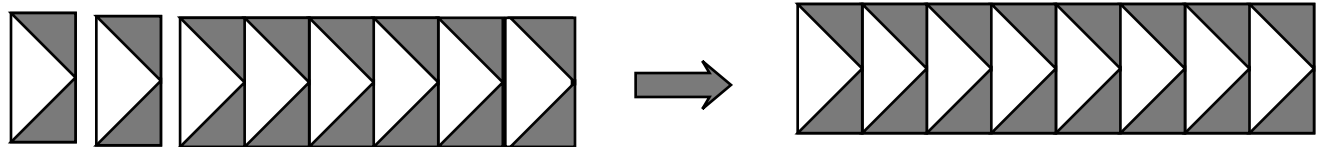
Make 1

Measures 4.5" x 16.5"

Make 2

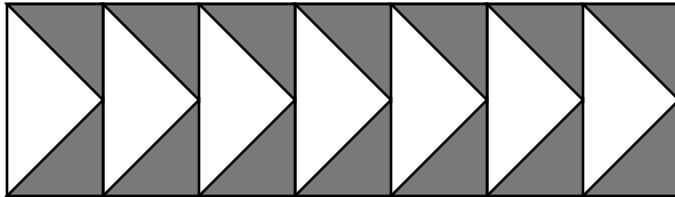

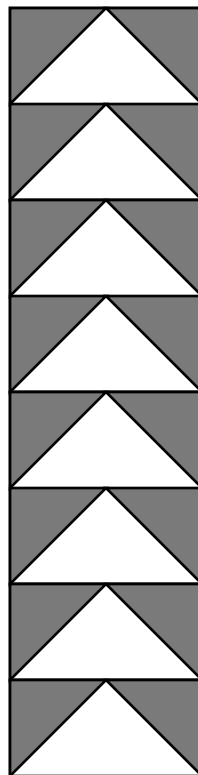

IN the Quilt it is finished size 4" x 14" MAKE 1

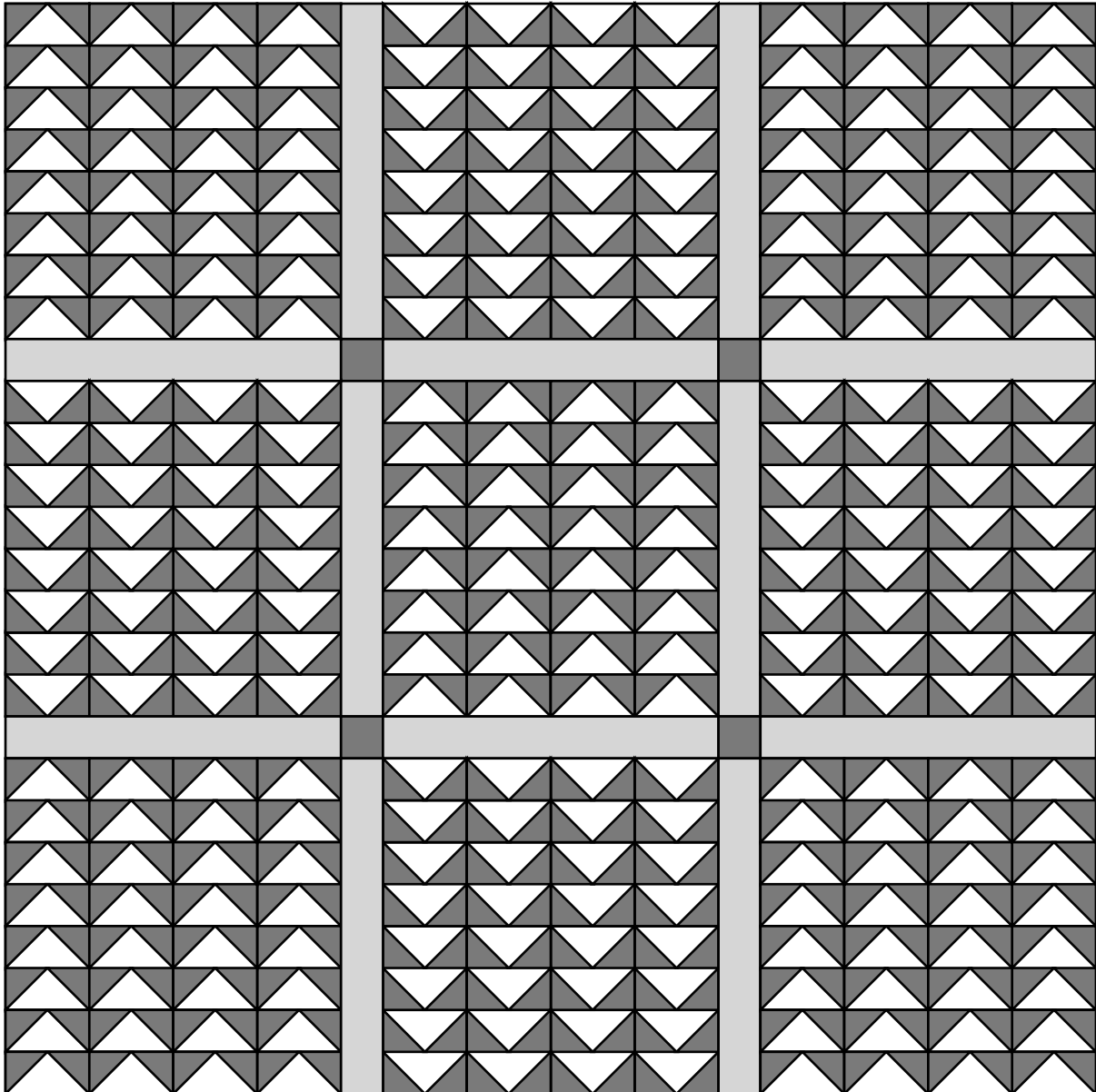

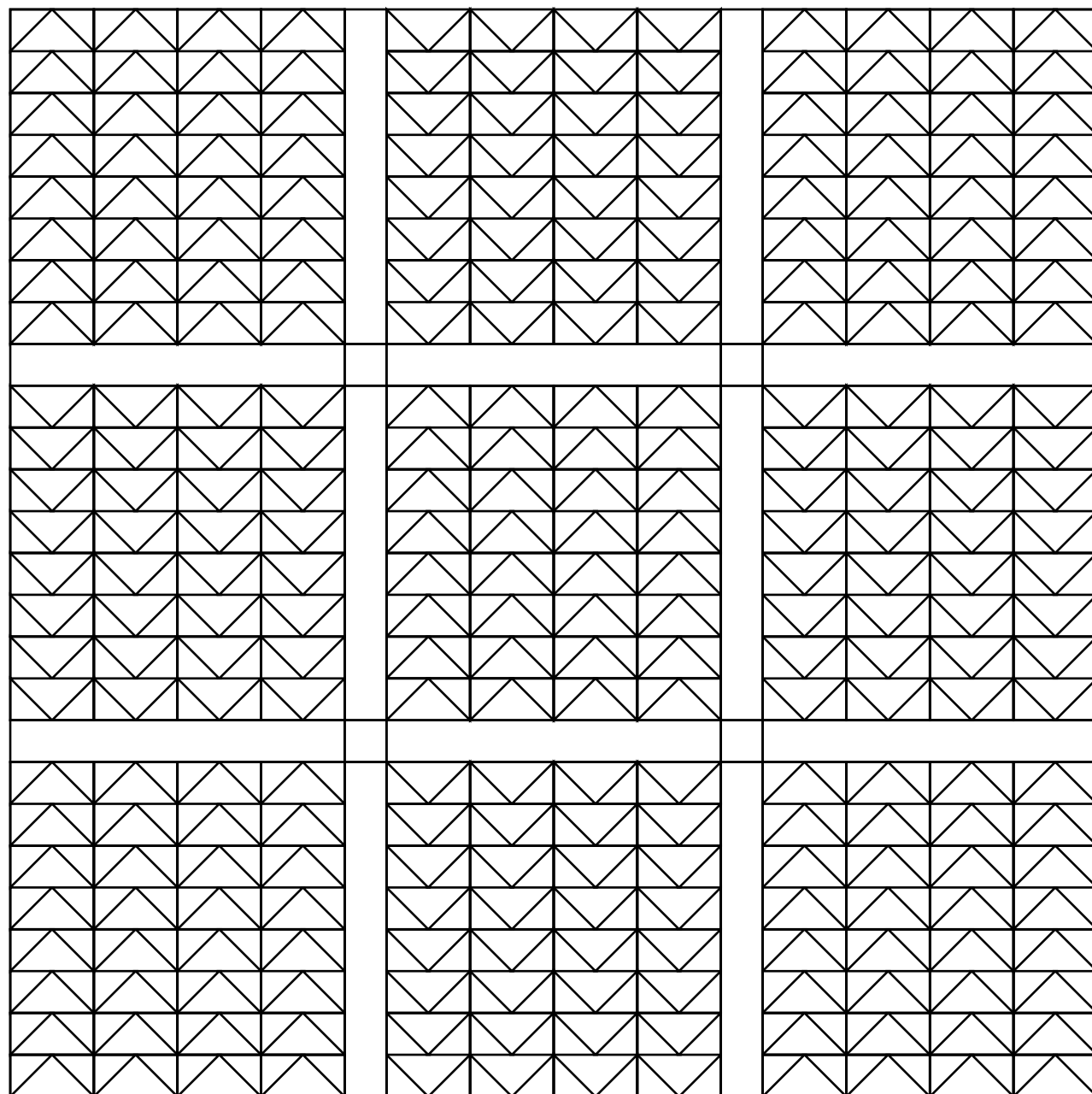
52.5" x 52.5" - 36 4.5" x 16.5" Blocks

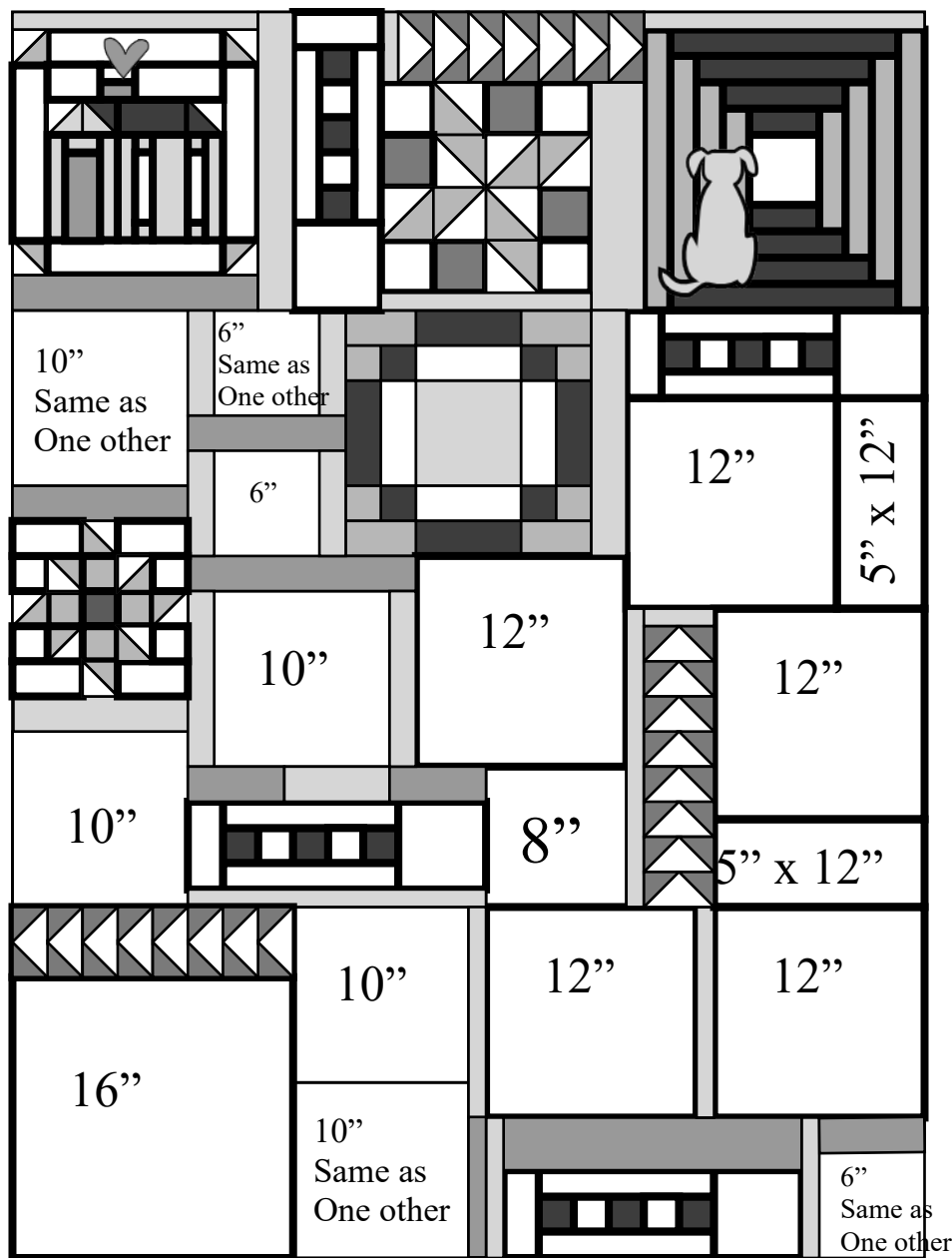
