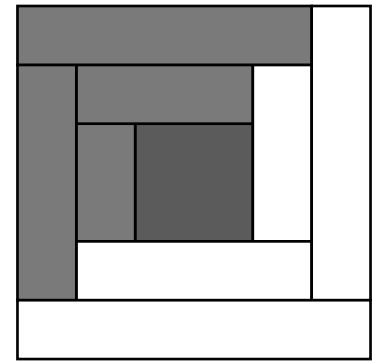




## Block 2 – Street Games

### Cutting Directions

#### Light fabrics

- Cut 1 strip 2.5" x 6.5"
- Cut 1 strip 2.5" x 8.5"
- Cut 1 strip 2.5" x 10.5"
- Cut 1 strip 2.5" x 12.5"

#### Medium center fabric

- Cut 1 strip 2.5" x 4.5"
- Cut 1 strip 2.5" x 6.5"
- Cut 1 strip 2.5" x 8.5"
- Cut 1 strip 2.5" x 10.5"

#### Dark Fabric

- Cut 1 square 4.5" x 4.5"

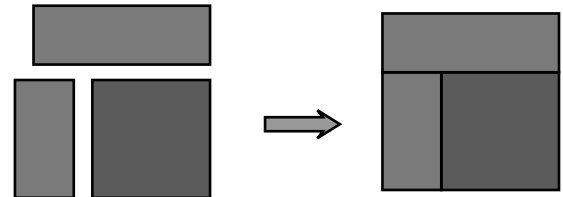
### Directions

1) Using the 4.5" dark square, 2.5" x 4.5" medium strip and 2.5" x 6.5" medium strip sew this unit

Measures

6.5" x 6.5"

Make 1 unit

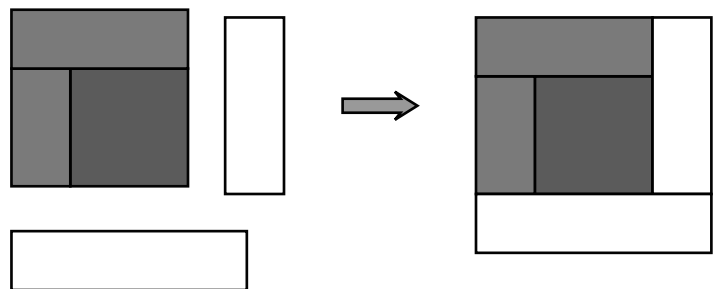


2) Using the 2.5" x 6.5" and 2.5" x 8.5" light strips, and The unit from step #1, sew this unit

Measures

8.5" x 8.5"

Make 1 unit

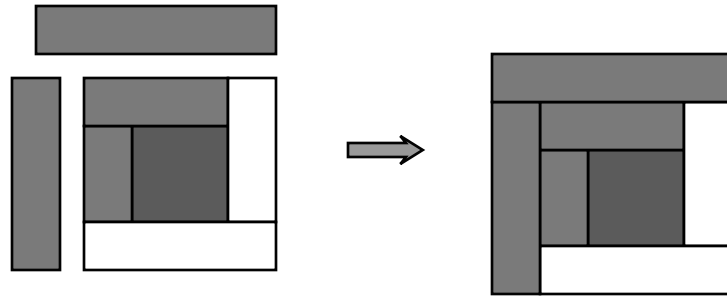

### Directions

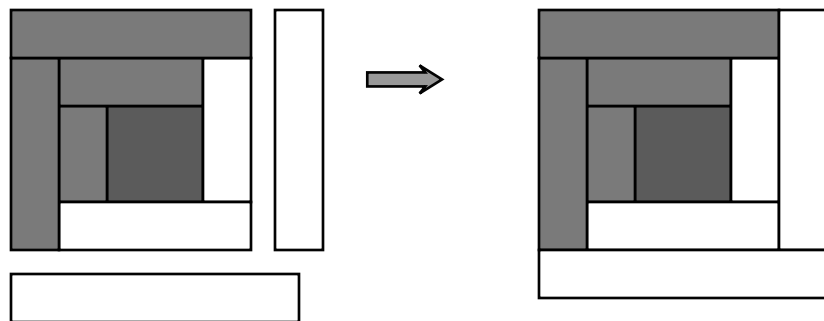
3) Using the 2.5" x 8.5" and 2.5" x 10.5" medium strips, and the unit from step #2, sew this unit

Measures  
10.5" x 10.5"  
Make 1 unit



4) Using the 2.5" x 10.5" and 2.5" x 12.5" light strips, and the unit from step #3, sew this unit

Measures  
12.5" x 12.5"  
Make 1 unit

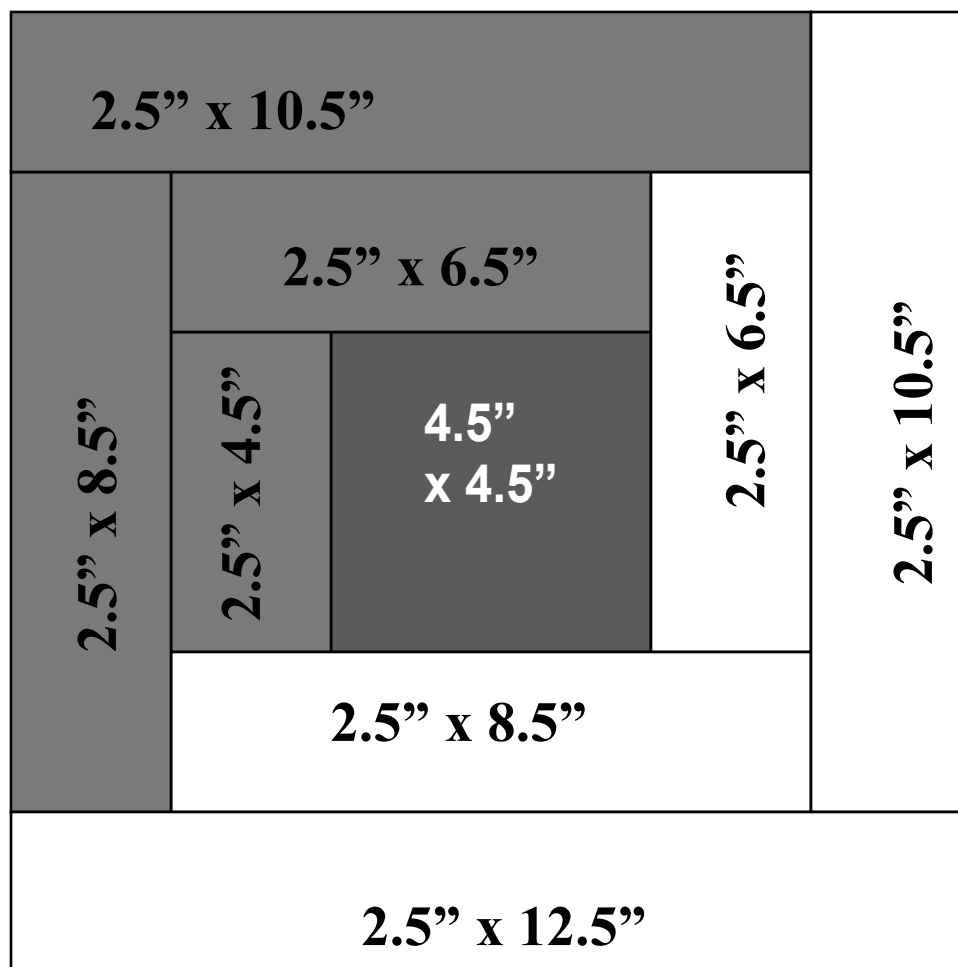

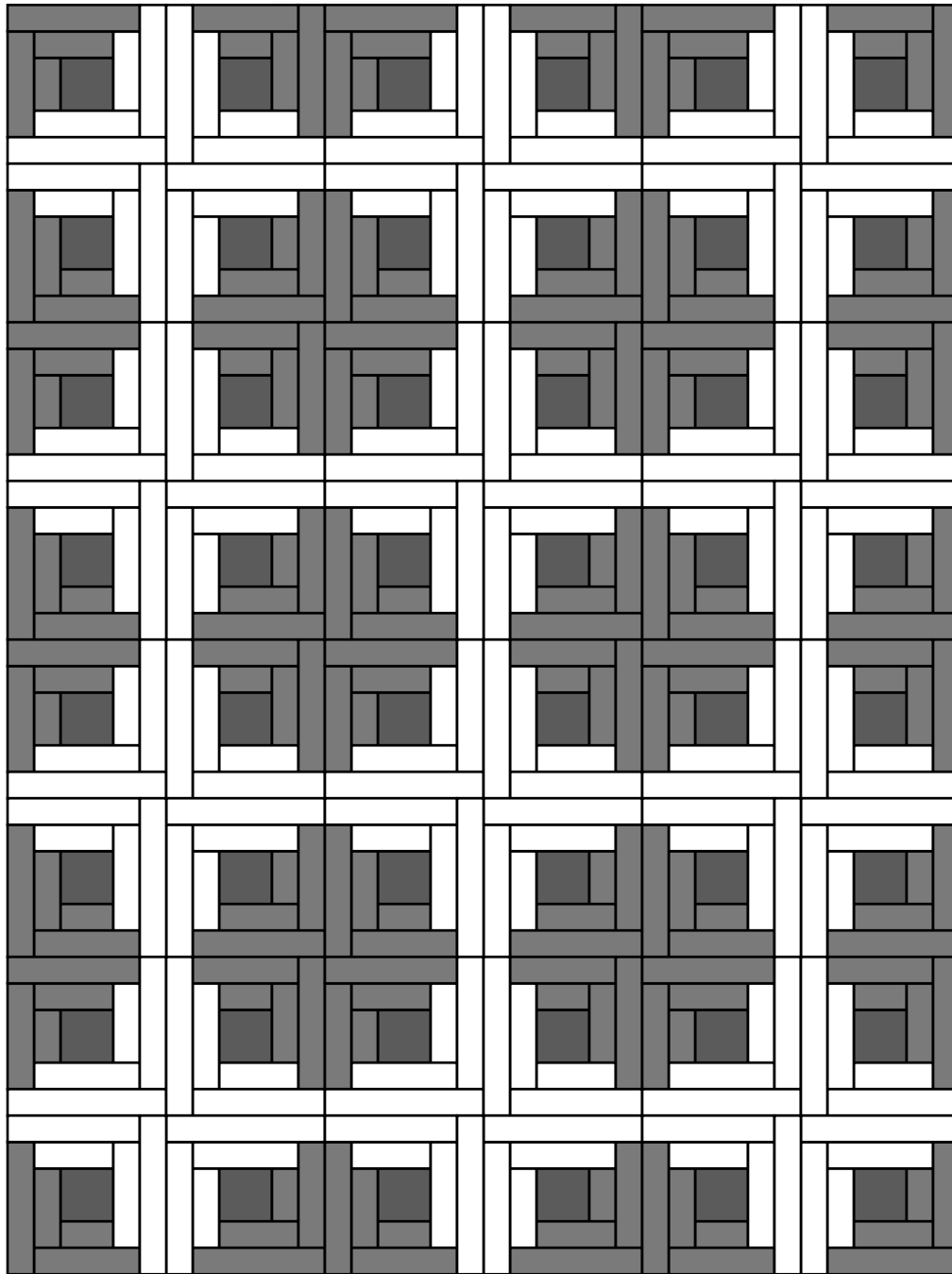

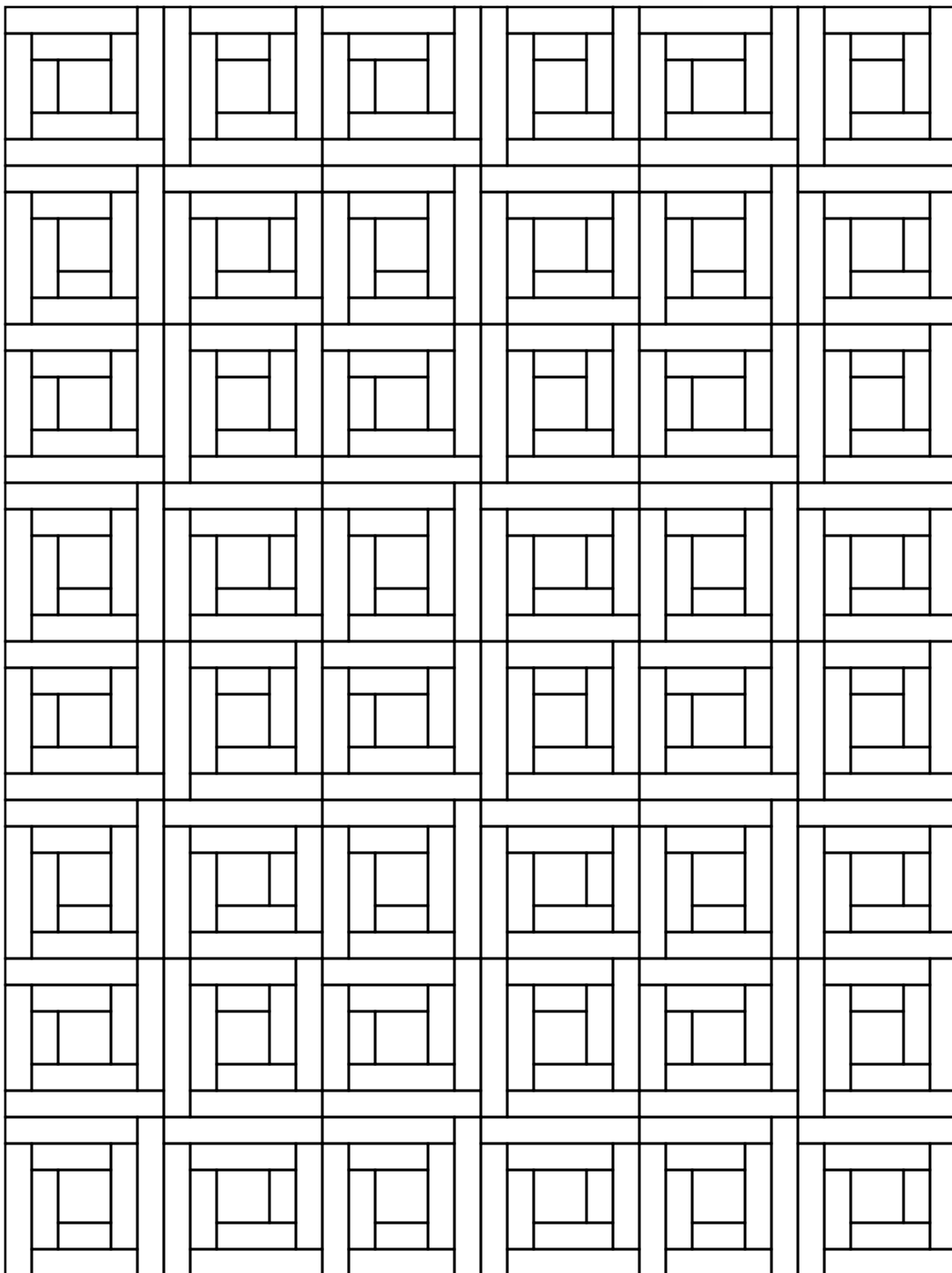
