## Supply List

Star Point fabric - 1 ½ yards  
Sashing fabric - 2 ½ yds  
Corner stones in sashing ½ yd  
Light Scraps - Approx total 3 yds  
9-patch Scraps - Approx total 3 ½ yds  
Backing - 6 yds

## Cutting Directions

### Star Point fabric

– Cut 80 squares 4” x 4” for Half Square Triangles (HST)

### Sashing fabric

– Cut 49 strips 2.5” x 12.5”  
– Cut 22 strips 2.5” x 6.5”

### Corner Stones fabric

– Cut 30 squares 2.5” x 2.5”

### Background fabrics

– Cut 80 squares 4” x 4” for Half Square Triangles (HST)  
– cut 80 squares 3.5” x 3.5”

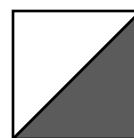
### 9-patch fabrics

– Cut 540 squares 2.5” x 2.5”

## Directions

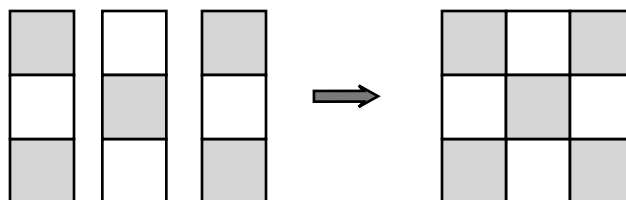
1) Using 4” background and 4” star point fabric squares make HSTs using method on my separate HST PDF sheet at the end

trim to 3.5” square  
Make 160



2) Following the diagram use 9 of your 9-patch 2.5” squares

Measures 6.5” x 6.5”  
Make 60 blocks

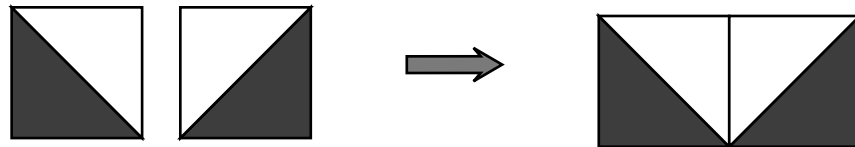

3) Following the diagram using 2 HST units sew them together

Measures 3.5" x 6.5"

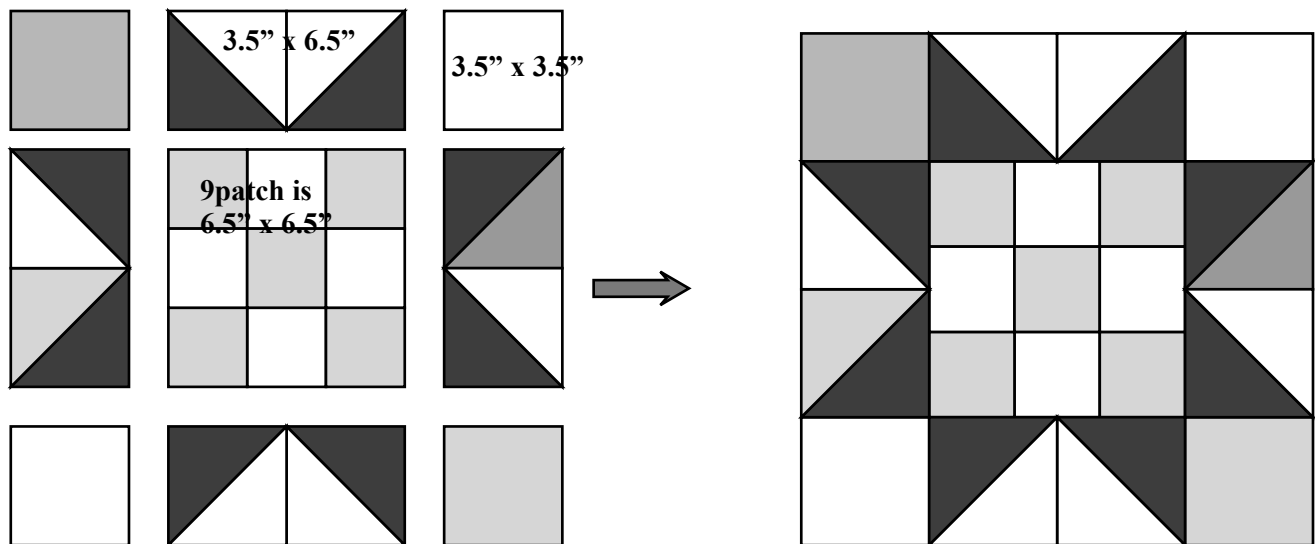
Make 80 units



4) Following the diagram using 4 units from above, a 9-patch block, and 4 squares 3.5" x 3.5" sew them together

Measures 12.5" x 12.5"

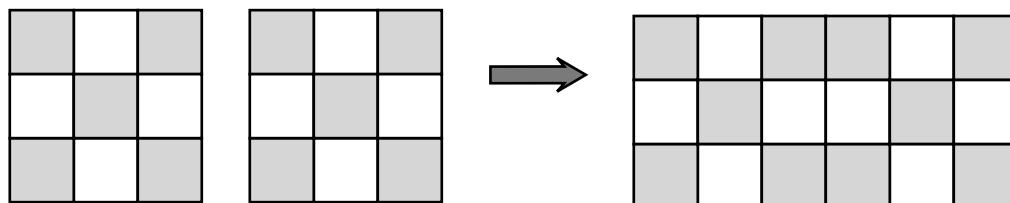
Make 20 Star blocks



5) Following the diagram, sew 2 9-patch units together.

Measures 6.5" x 12.5"

Make 18



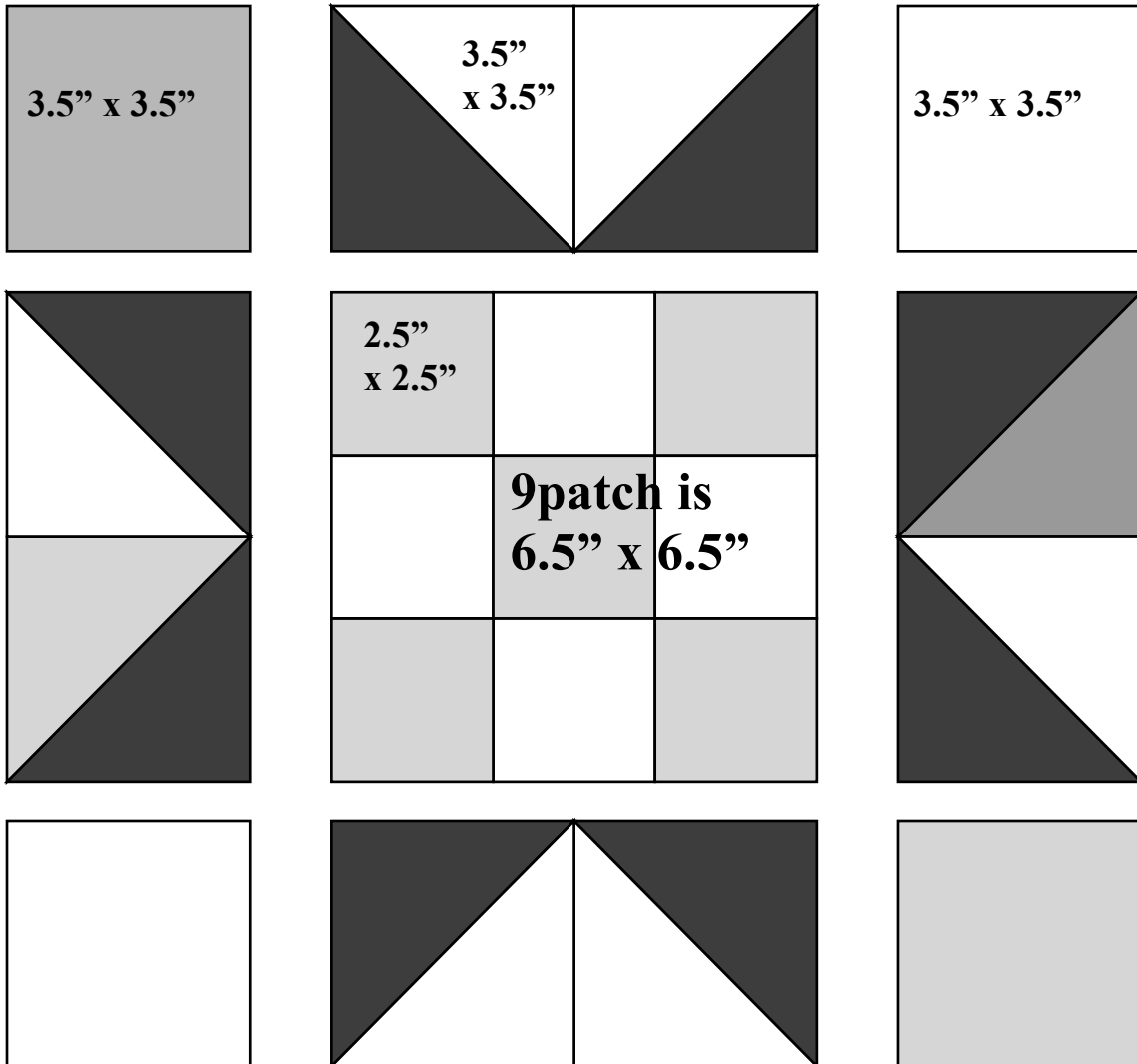

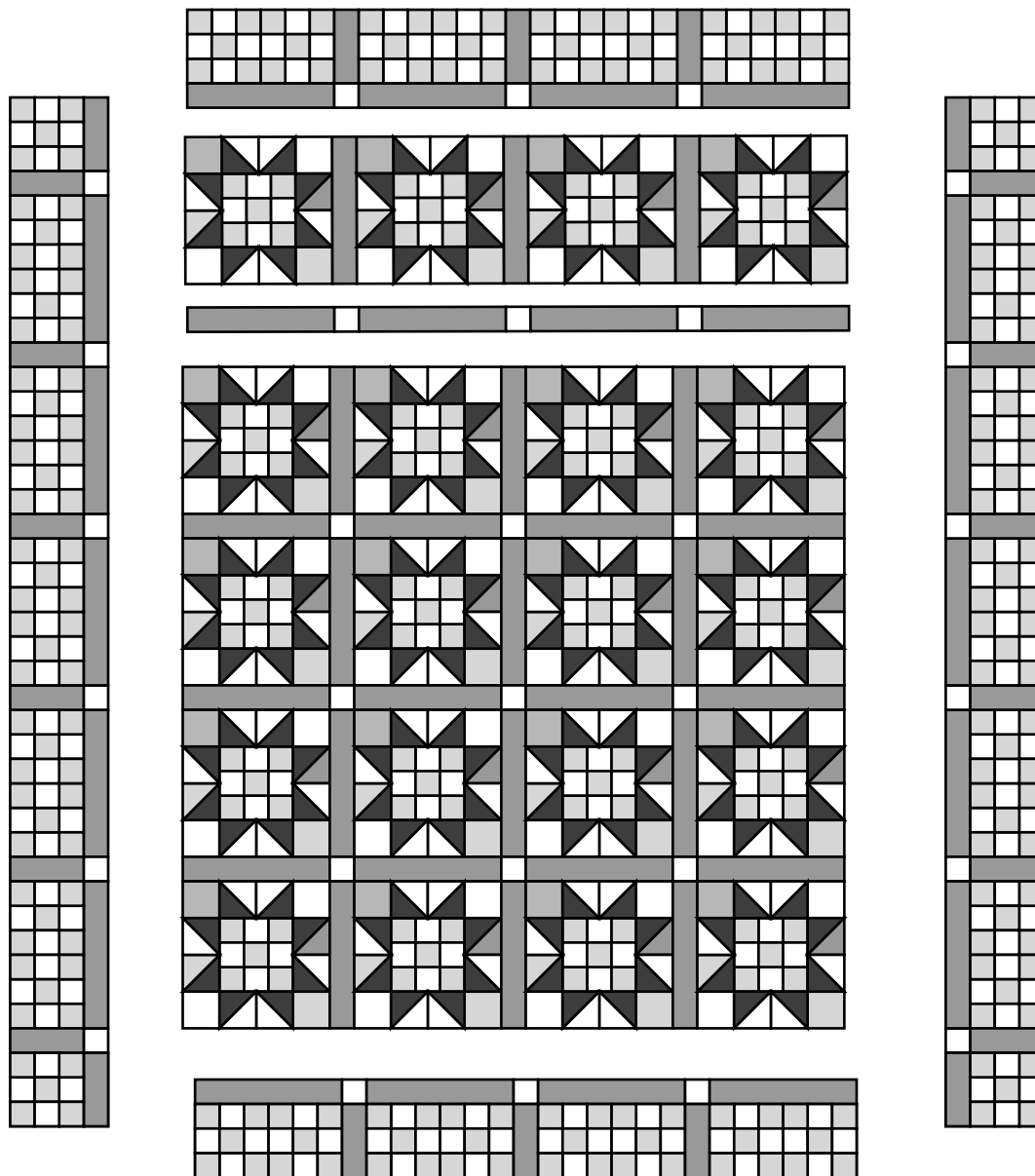

Measures 70.5" x 84.5"

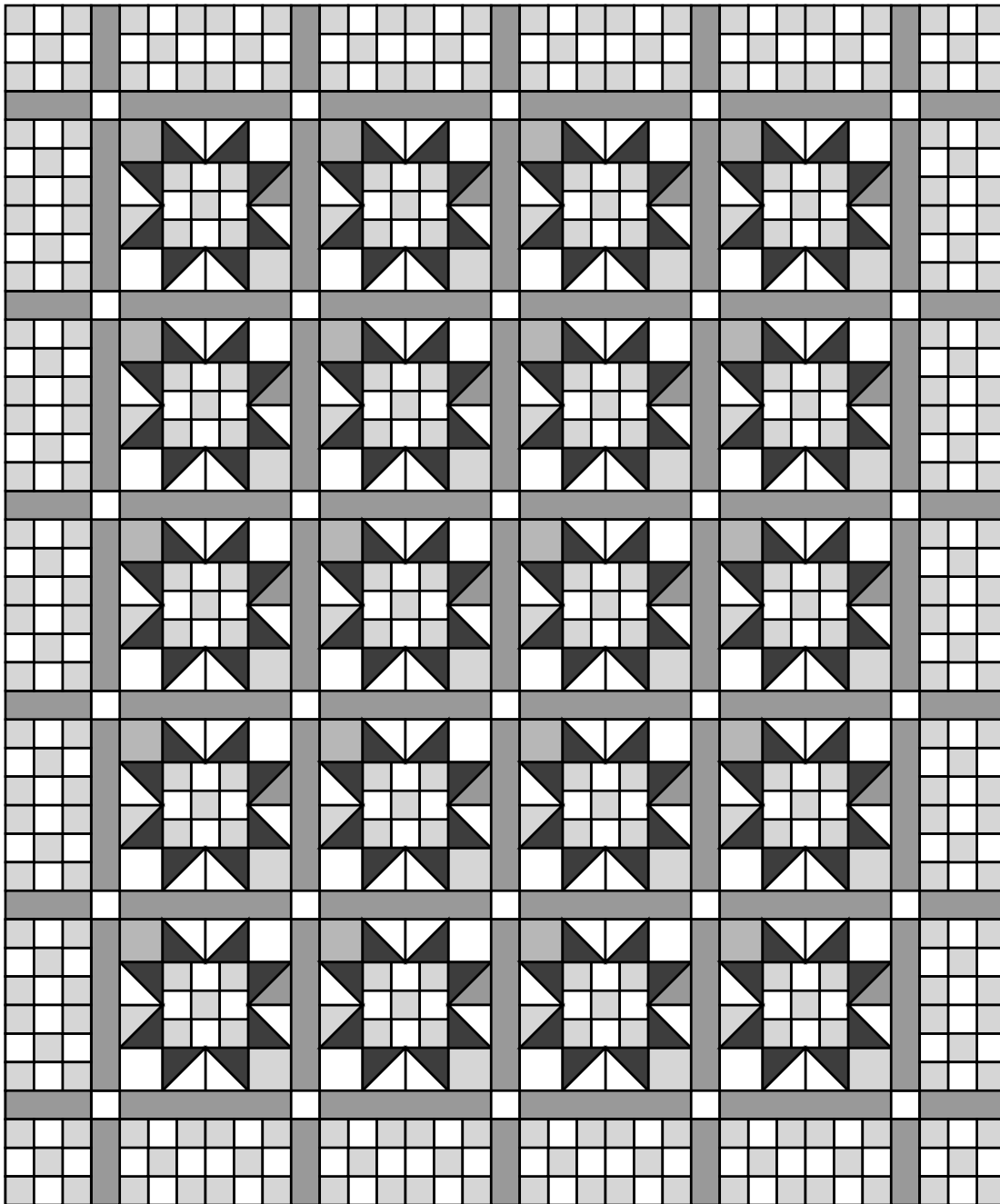

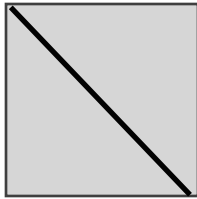

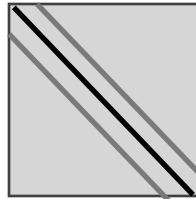
## Half Square Triangles Tutorial

"Pat Sloan's Teach Me to Sew Triangles"**



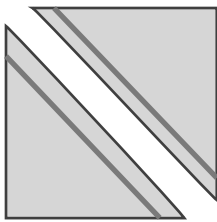
**Step 1**

- Draw a line on the back of all the lighter squares



**Step 2**

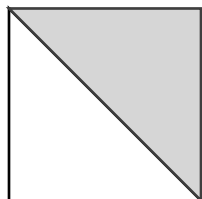
- Layer the 2 squares  
- Sew a  $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam on both Sides of the drawn line



**Step 3**

Cut on the drawn Line for 2 HST

**Step 4**



-Trim squares to size needed using a square ruler with a diagonal line placed on the Seam.
