## Cutting & Sewing

### Background white Fabric

- Cut 1 square 8.5" x 8.5"
- Cut 10 squares 3" x 3" for HST

### Floral Fabric

- Cut 10 squares 3" x 3" for HST

### Red Print 1 & 2

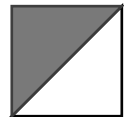
- Cut 1 strawberry from each

### Green print

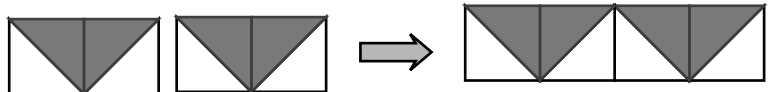
- Cut 2 strawberry tops
- Cut 2 strawberry stems

### Half Square Triangles

- 1) Sew the 3" white and floral squares  
 Using HST method on next last page.  
 Make 20 units - trim to 2.5" square



- 2) Following the diagram assemble 4 Hst units together  
 Make 4 - Measures 2.5" x 8.5"



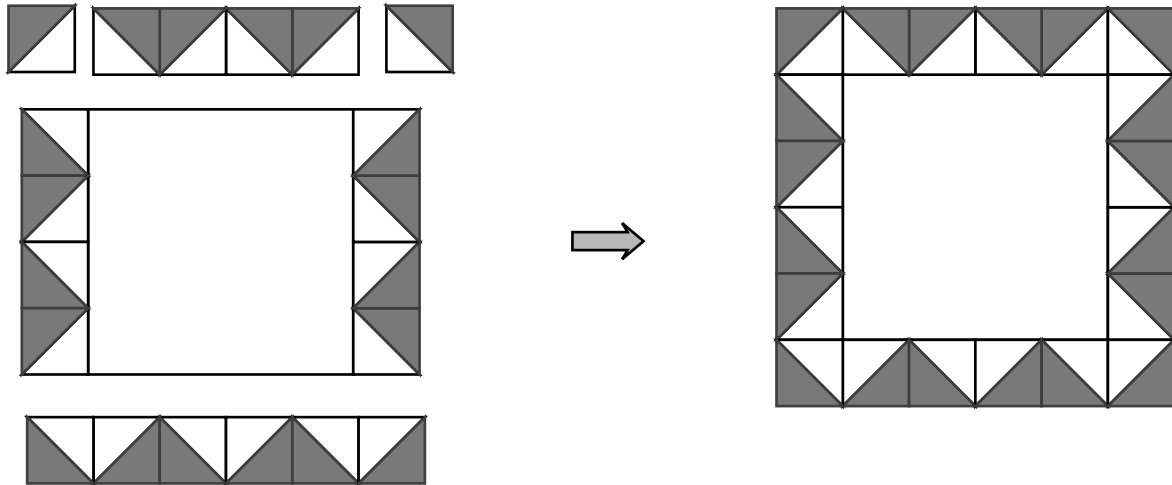

## Assemble the block

3) Following the diagrams assemble the block. NOTE that I have the light triangles on the inside next to the light square.

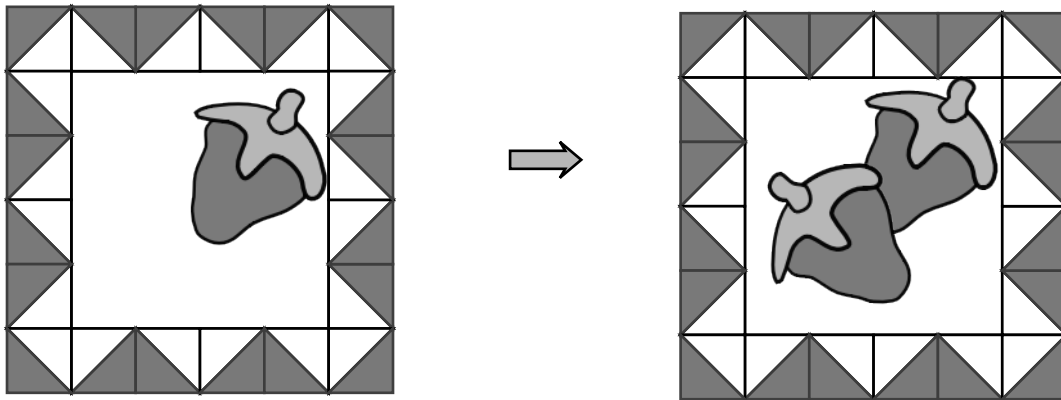
Make 1 - Measures 12.5" x 12.5"



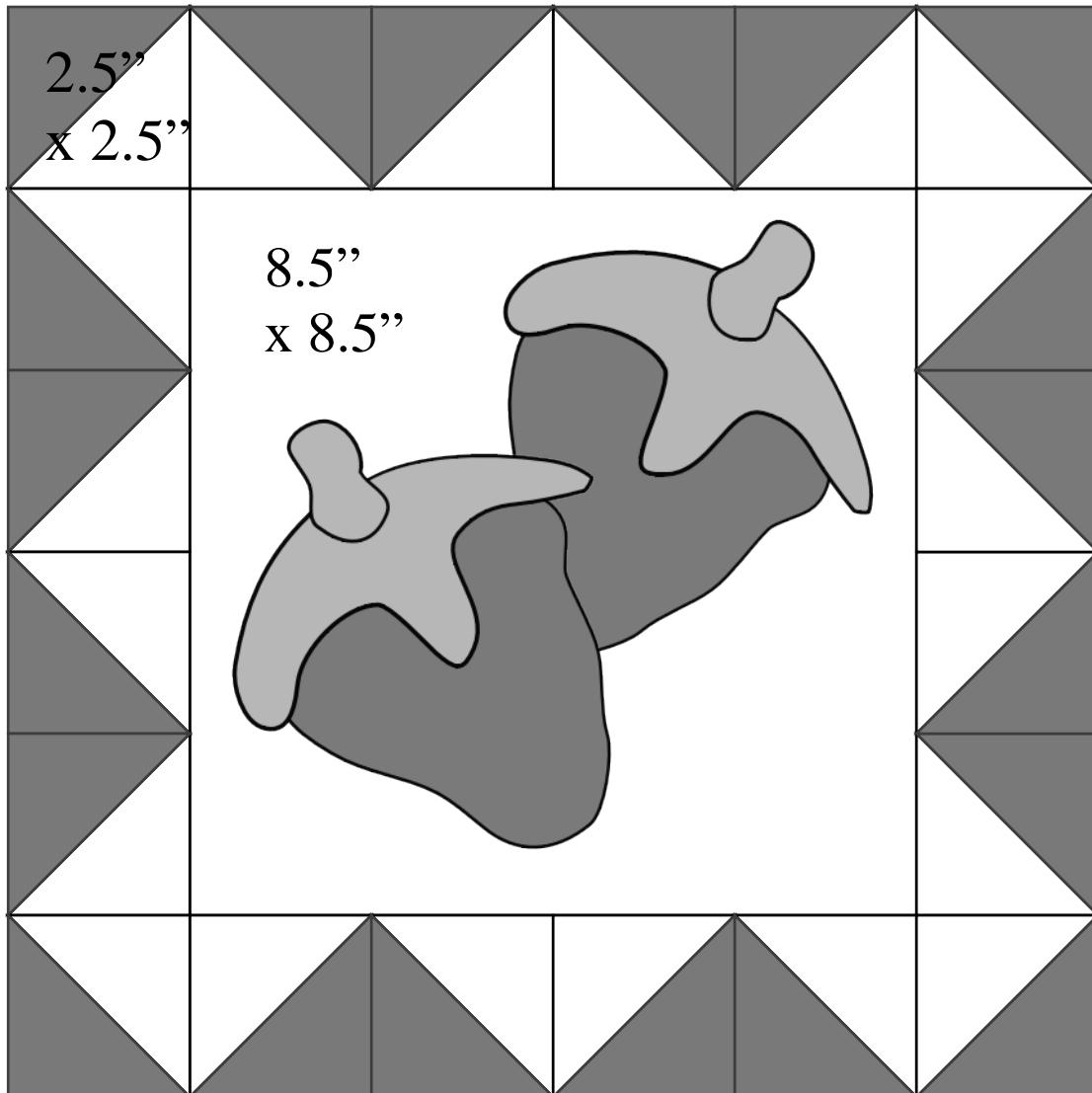
4) Following the diagrams fuse the lower strawberry.

Then position the 2<sup>nd</sup> strawberry Applique

Make 1 - Measures 12.5" x 12.5"



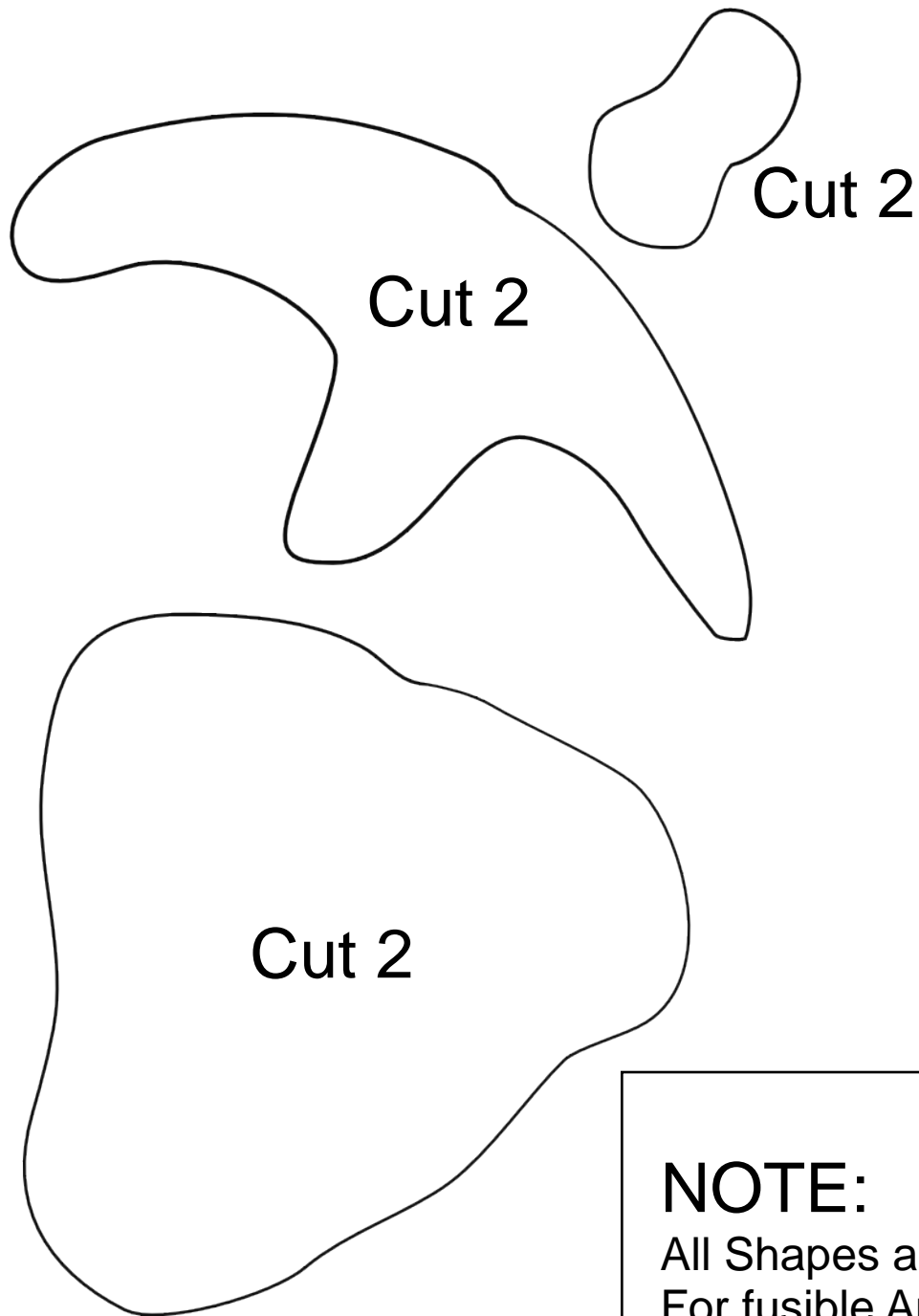

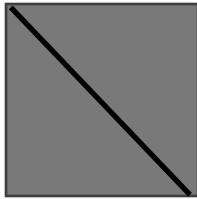

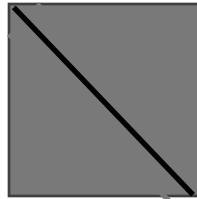
## Half Square Triangles Tutorial

**NOTE- For other ways to make HST units, see my book  
"Pat Sloan's Teach Me to Sew Triangles"**



**Step 1**

- Draw a line on the back of all the lighter squares



**Step 2**

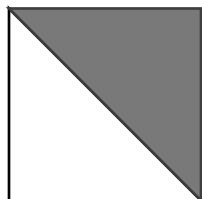
- Layer the 2 squares  
- Sew a  $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam on both Sides of the drawn line



**Step 3**

Cut on the drawn Line for 2 HST

**Step 4**



-Trim squares to 2.5" x 2.5" using a square ruler with a diagonal line placed on the Seam.
