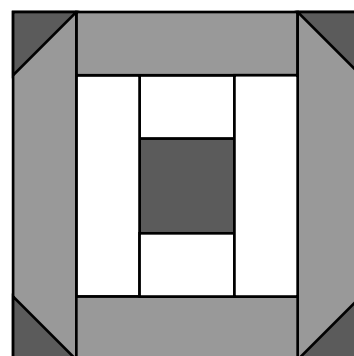
After a crazy year of being in a Pandemic I decided we need to sew a little 'Hope'.

Block is 11.5" x 11.5"
Finished size 11" x 11"

Cutting Directions

Center square fabric

– Cut 1 square 3.5" x 3.5"

Inner Frame fabric

– Cut 2 strips 2.5" x 7.5"

– Cut 2 strips 2.5" x 3.5"

Outer Frame fabric

– Cut 2 strips 2.5" x 7.5"

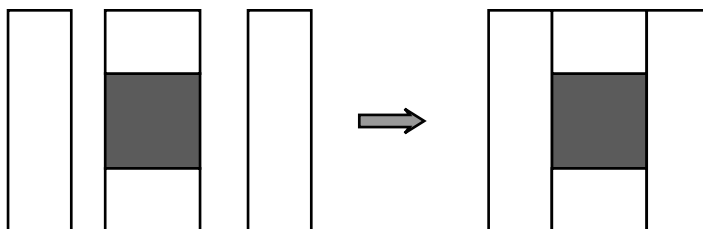
– Cut 2 strips 2.5" x 11.5"

Corner fabric

– Cut 4 squares 2.5" x 2.5"

Directions

1) Following the diagram sew a inner frame 2.5" x 3.5" strip to the top and bottom of the center square
Sew a inner frame 2.5" x 7.5" to the sides
Measures 7.5" x 7.5"
Make 1

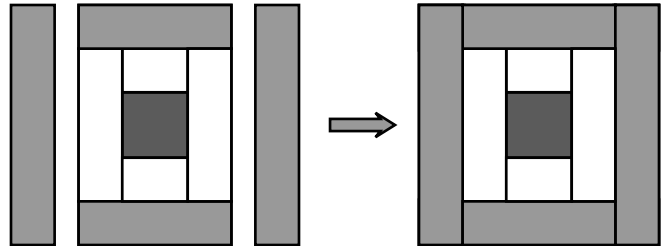
Directions

2) Following the diagram sew a outer frame 2.5" x 7.5" strip to the top and bottom of the Unit from step #1

Sew a outer frame 2.5" x 11.5" to the sides

Measures 11.5" x 11.5"

Make 1



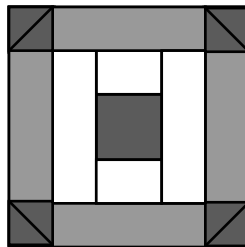
3) Following the diagram, place a corner 2.5" square on the left corner of the block.

Sew ON the line.

Repeat for all 4 corners

Make 1

Measures 11.5" x 11.5"

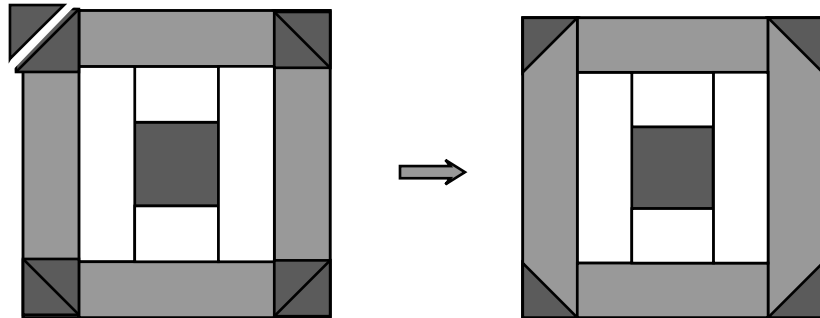


4) Following the diagram trim away leaving a 1/4" seam allowance on all 4 corners

Press triangles open

Make 1

Measures 11.5" x 11.5"



5) For the sew along make these scrappy, alternate lights and darks, have fun!

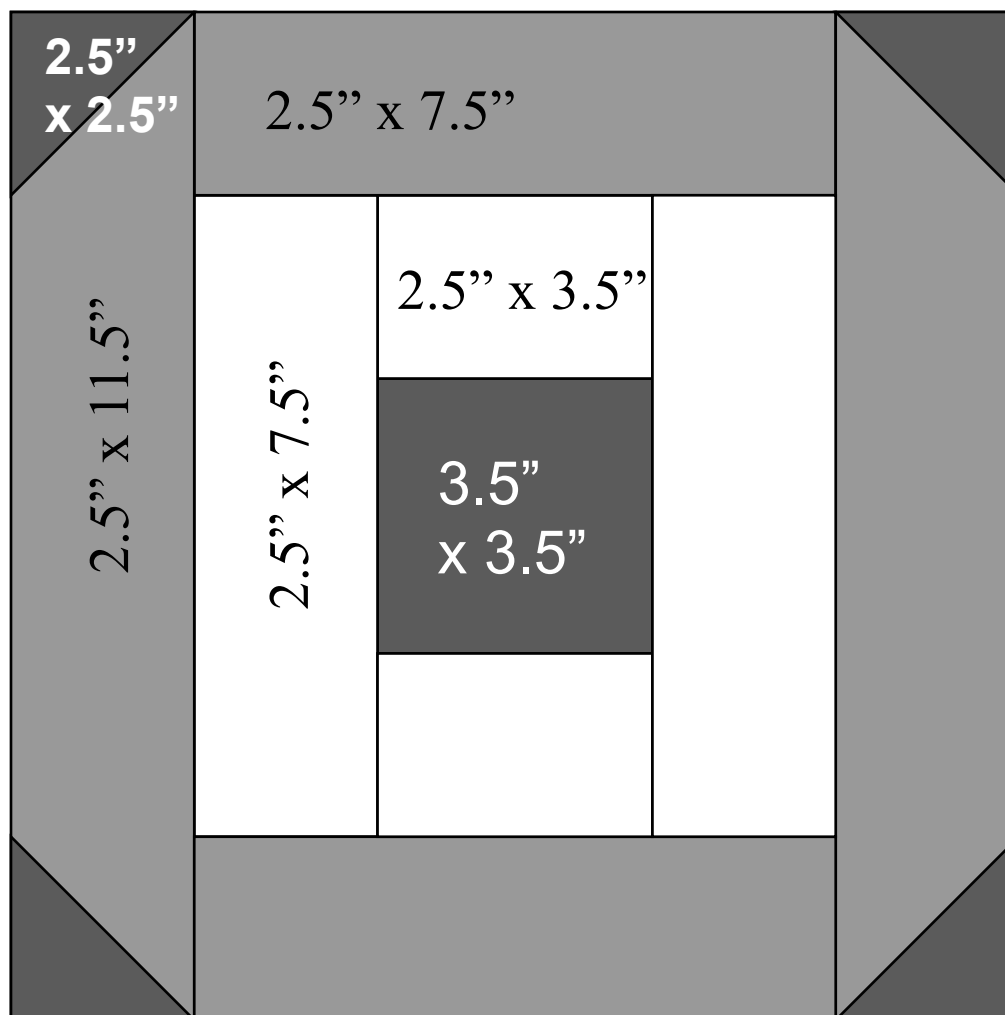

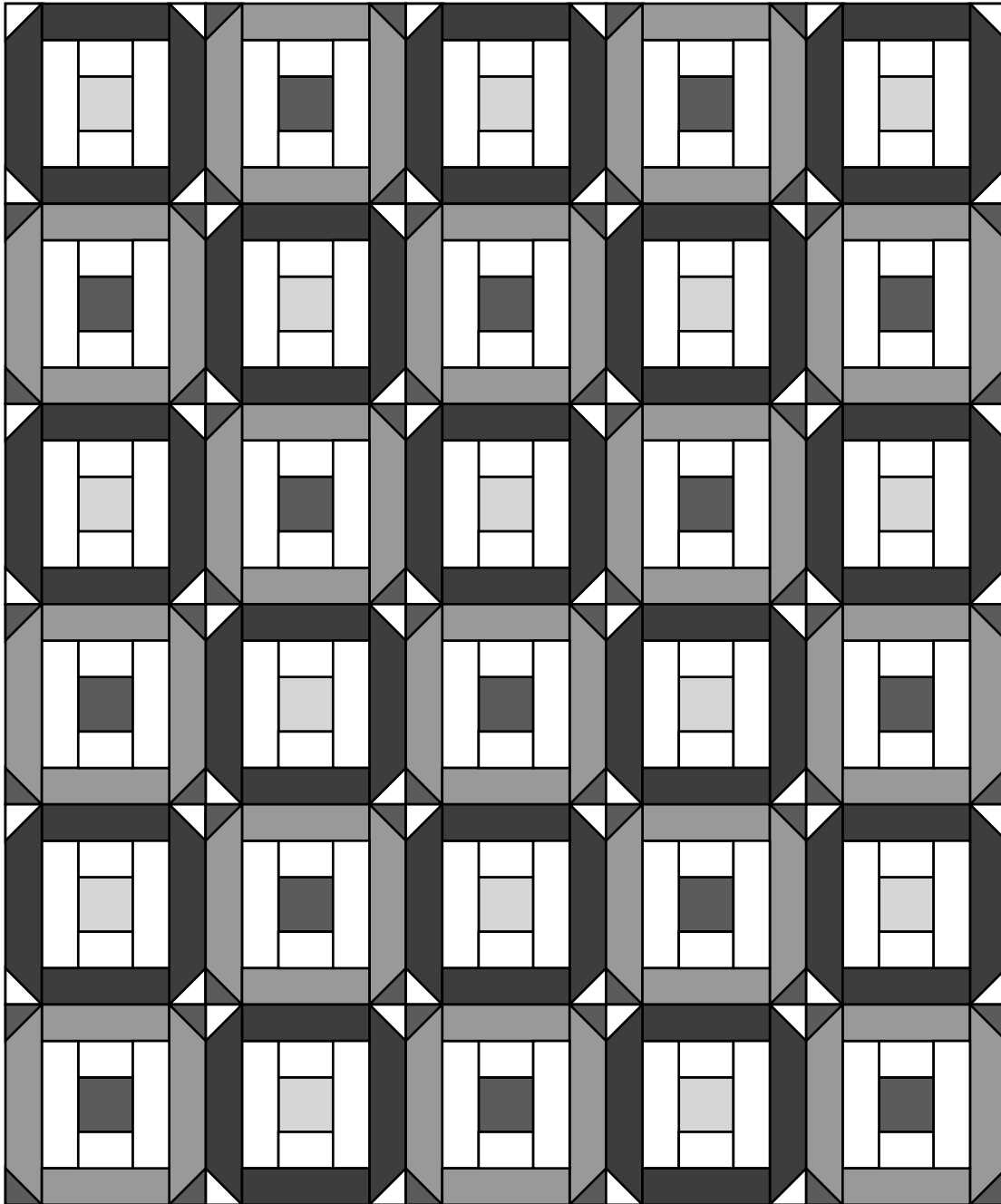

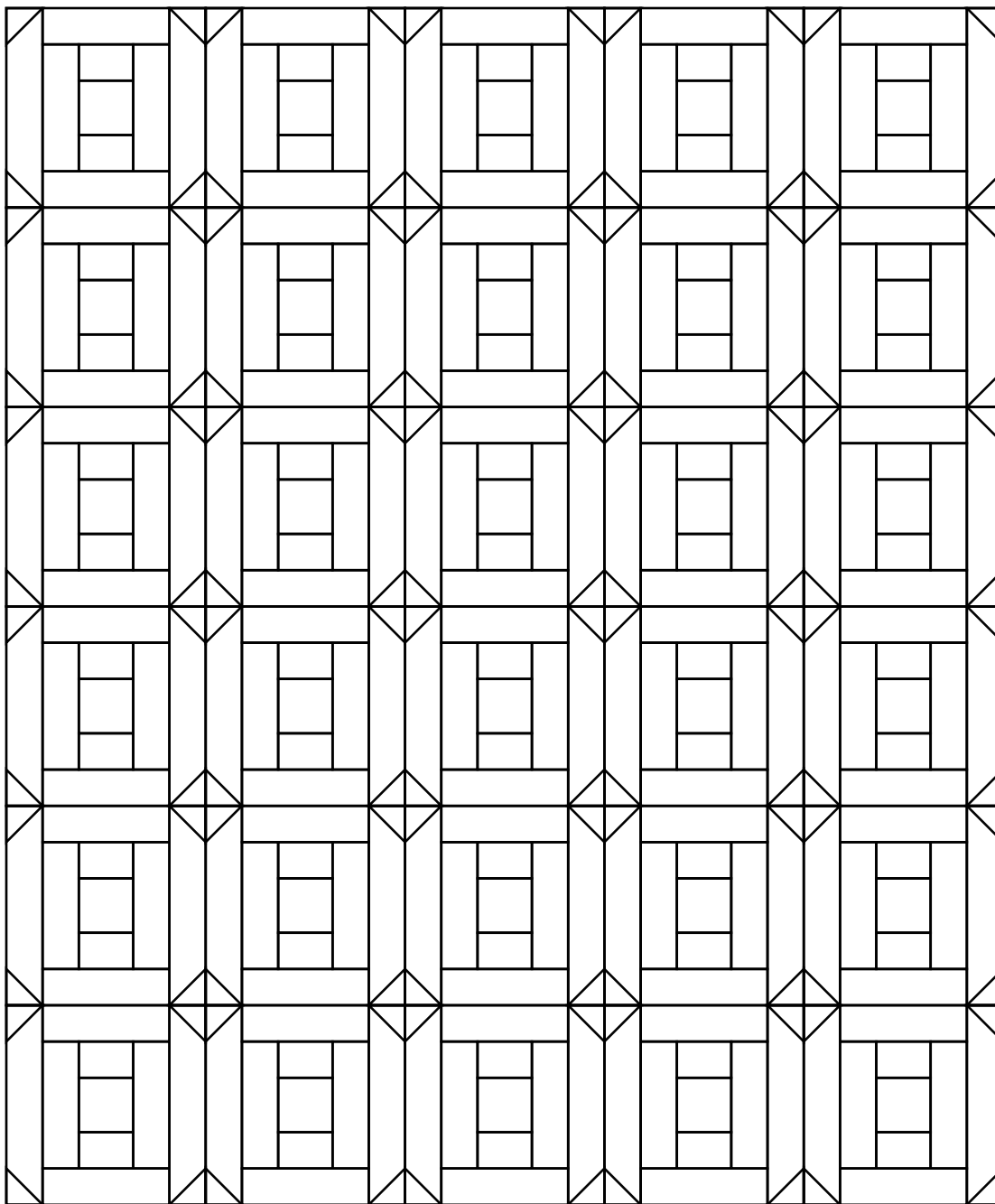
