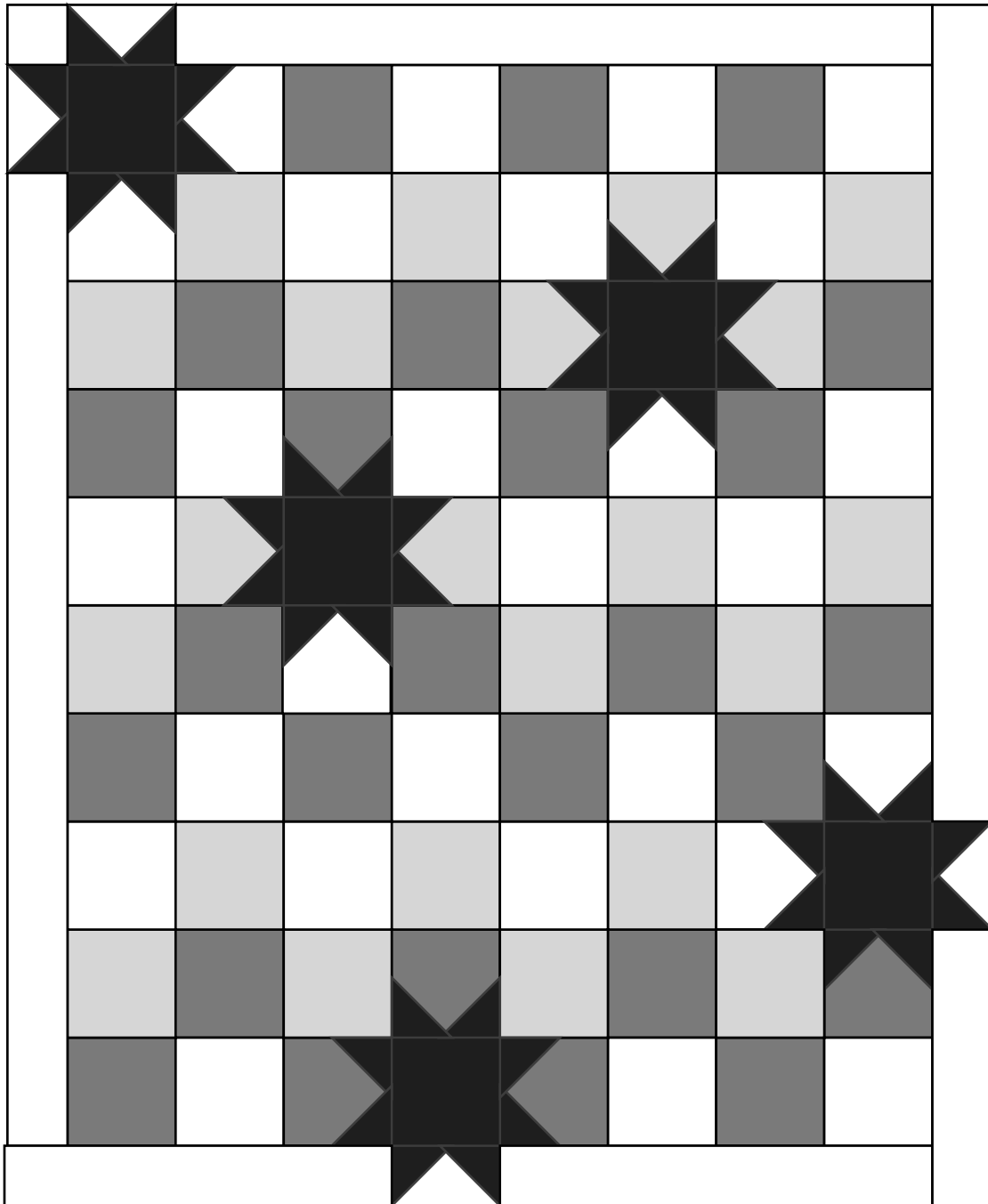

Supplies & Cutting

Charm Squares -total of 75 squares 5" x 5"

- 2 Charm packs of 42 each
- Or cut 75 squares 5" x 5"

Star Fabric - Total 1/2 yd

- Cut 5 squares 5" x 5"
- Cut 40 squares 3" x 3"

Draw a diagonal line on the back of each

Border Fabric - Total 1 1/4yd if you Do not want to piece any border Sections OR 2/3yd where you piece The longest border

- Cut 1 strip 3" x 41"
- Cut 1 strip 3" x 34.5"
- Cut 1 strip 3" x 32"
- Cut 1 strip 3" x 18.5"
- Cut 1 strip 3" x 16.5"
- Cut 1 strip 3" x 12"
- Cut 4 rectangles 3" x 5"
- Cut 1 square 3" x 3"

Binding Fabric 1/2 yd
Backing Fabric 2 yds

Finished Size 41" x 50"

TIPS

- Layout the squares before making the stars for color placement
- If using directional fabric, note placement so they are the direction you want them to be.

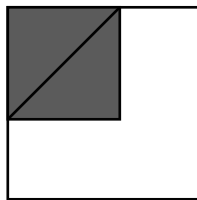

Block Directions

1) Following diagram place the small star square on a background square, right sides together sew ON the line.

Make 16

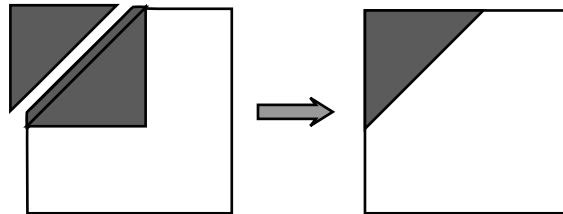
Measures 5" x 5"



2) Following diagram trim away Leaving a 1/4" seam allowance

Trim all 16

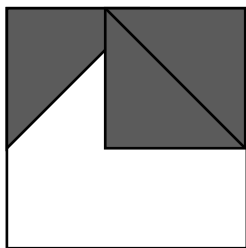
Measures 5" x 5"



3) Following diagram place another small star square on a background, right sides together sew ON the line.

Make 16

Measures 5" x 5"

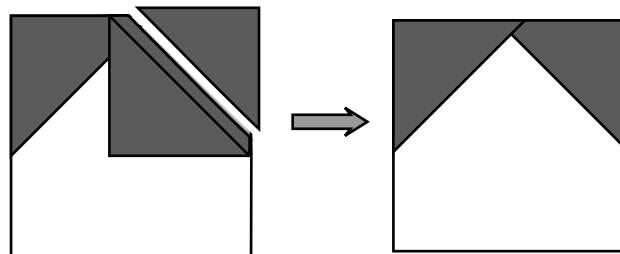


4) Following diagram trim away The other side leaving a 1/4" seam allowance

Trim 16

Press triangles open to make a square

Measures 5" x 5"

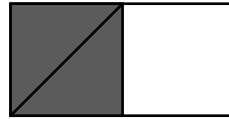

5) Following diagram place the small star square on a 3" x 5" border rectangle right sides together. Sew ON the line.

Make 4

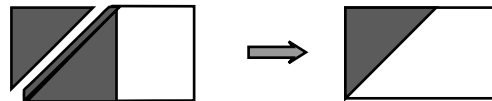
Measures 3" x 5"



6) Following diagram trim away Leaving a 1/4" seam allowance

Trim all 4

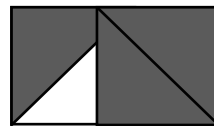
Measures 3" x 5"



7) Following diagram place another small star square on the border rectangle right sides together. sew ON the line.

Make 4

Measures 3" x 5"

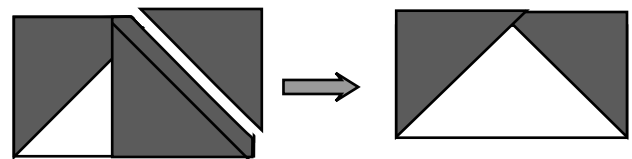


8) Following diagram trim away The other side leaving a 1/4" seam allowance

Trim 4

Press triangles open to make a rectangle

Measures 3" x 5"

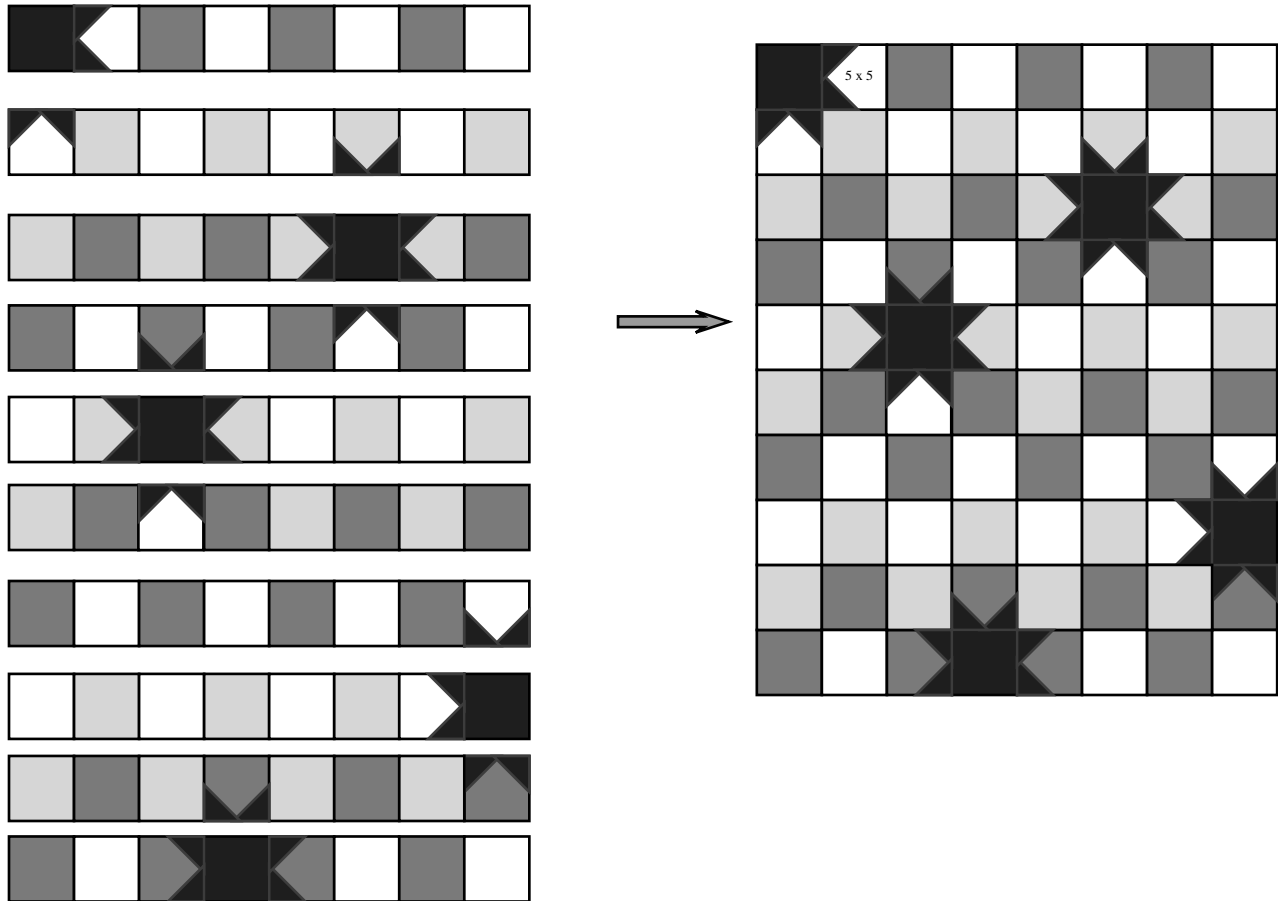
9) Following diagram sew the center in rows.

Then sew the rows to each other.

TIP - Press seam allowances all to the right on 1st row, then all to the left on the 2nd row.

Repeat so that rows nest together nicely.

Measures 40.5" x 50.5"

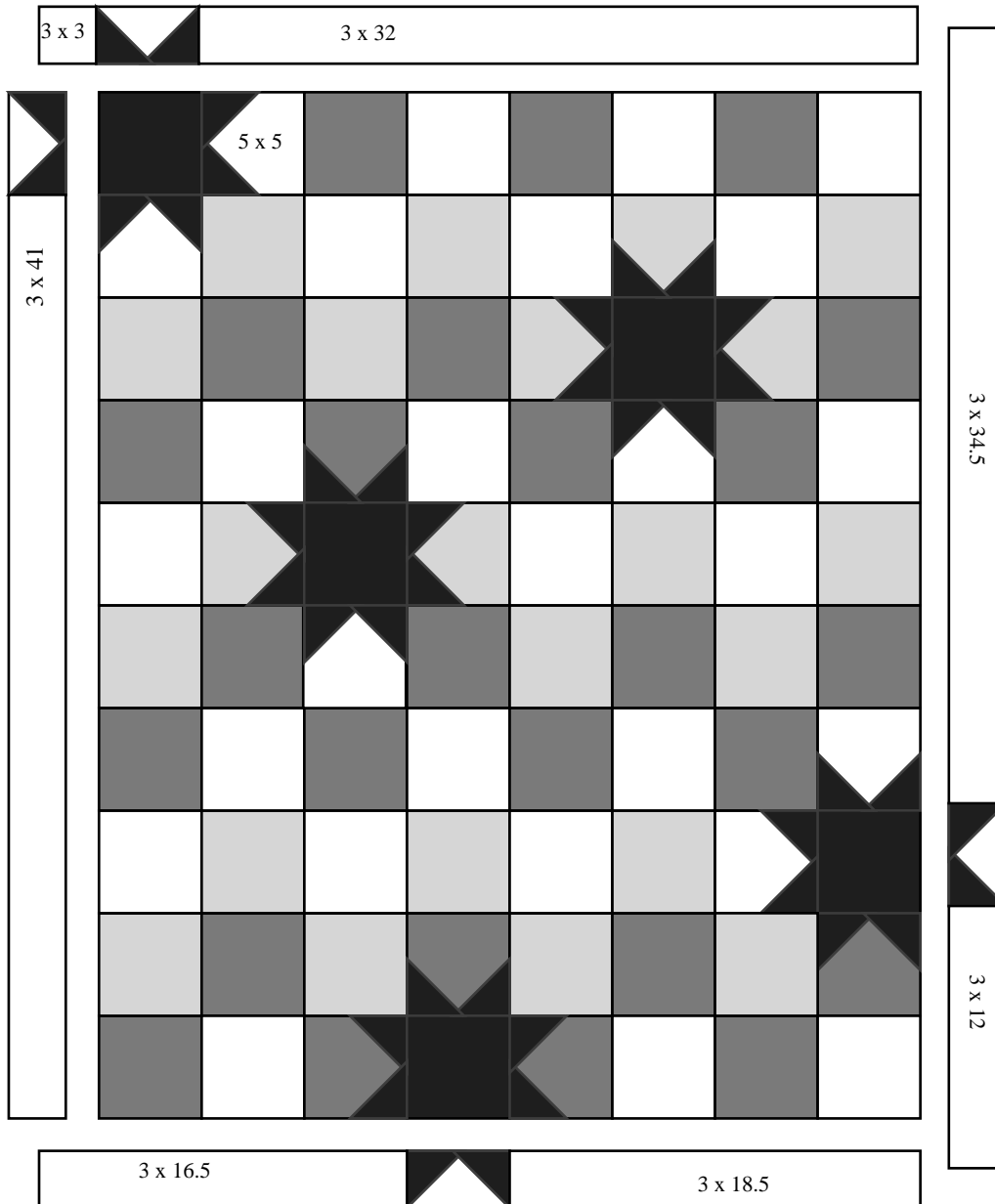

Sew the top and bottom to the center

Sew the right side to the center

Finished Size 41.5" x 50.5"
