Cutting Directions for 12" finished blocks

This layout can be used with
any set of 12" blocks
I designed it for the Old
School Block of the Month in 2021

****Sashing**

**2.5 yds of sashing fabric. Also
used in some of the churn dash
blocks. If you want the
background the same for ALL
Churn dash get 3 yds**

- cut 31 strips 6.5" x 12.5"

****Border**

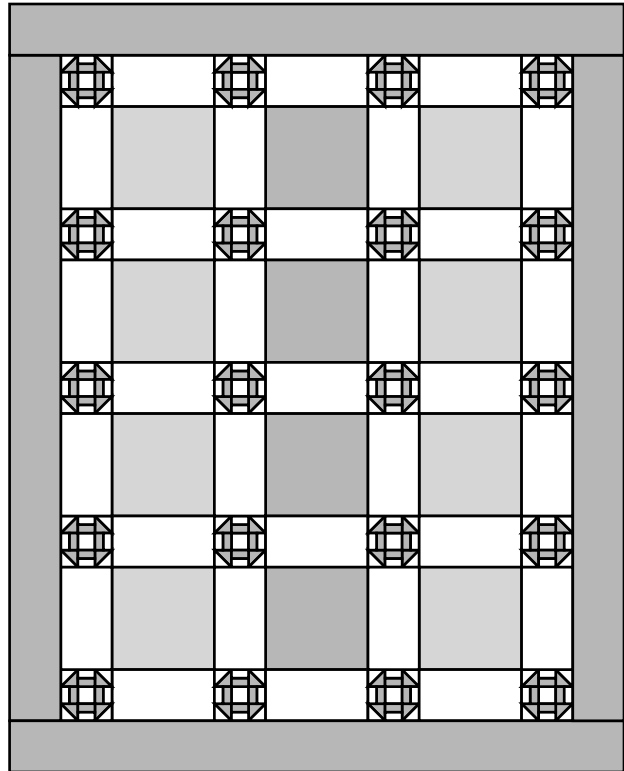
2 1/3 yds for uncut border

- Cut 2 borders 6.5" x 72.5" (top/bottom)

- Cut 2 borders 6.5" x 78.5" (sides)

Sew top and bottom borders first

Then side borders



60 x 78 no border

72 x 90 with border

Cutting for 20 Churndash blocks

Light Fabric

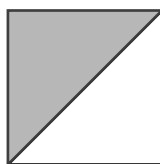
- Cut 40 squares 3" x 3" for HST (Half square Triangles)
- Cut 20 strip 1.5" x 11"
- Cut 20 square 2.5" x 2.5"

Dark Fabric

- Cut 40 squares 3" x 3" for HST (Half square Triangles)
- Cut 20 strip 1.5" x 11"

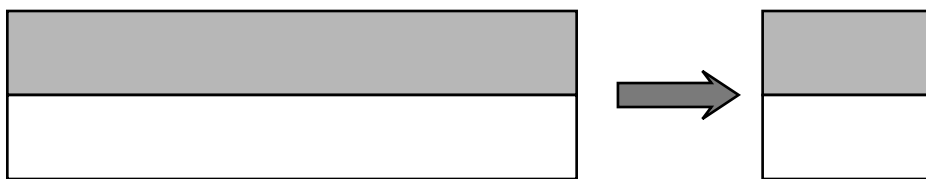
Directions

1) Sew a light 3" squares and a dark 3" squares Using HST method on last page. Make 4 units - trim to 2.5" square



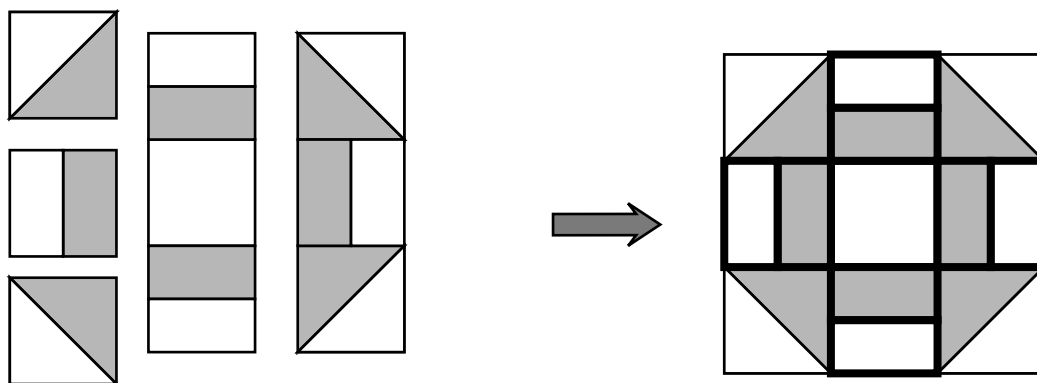
2) Sew a light 1.5" strip to a dark 1.5" strip Sub cut into 2.5" x 2.5" units Make 4 units

REPEAT to make The 2nd block



3) Following the diagram, sew the block using the 4 HST, the 4 units from step 2 And the 2.5" square Measures to 6.5" x 6.5" square

Make 20 blocks for your quilt



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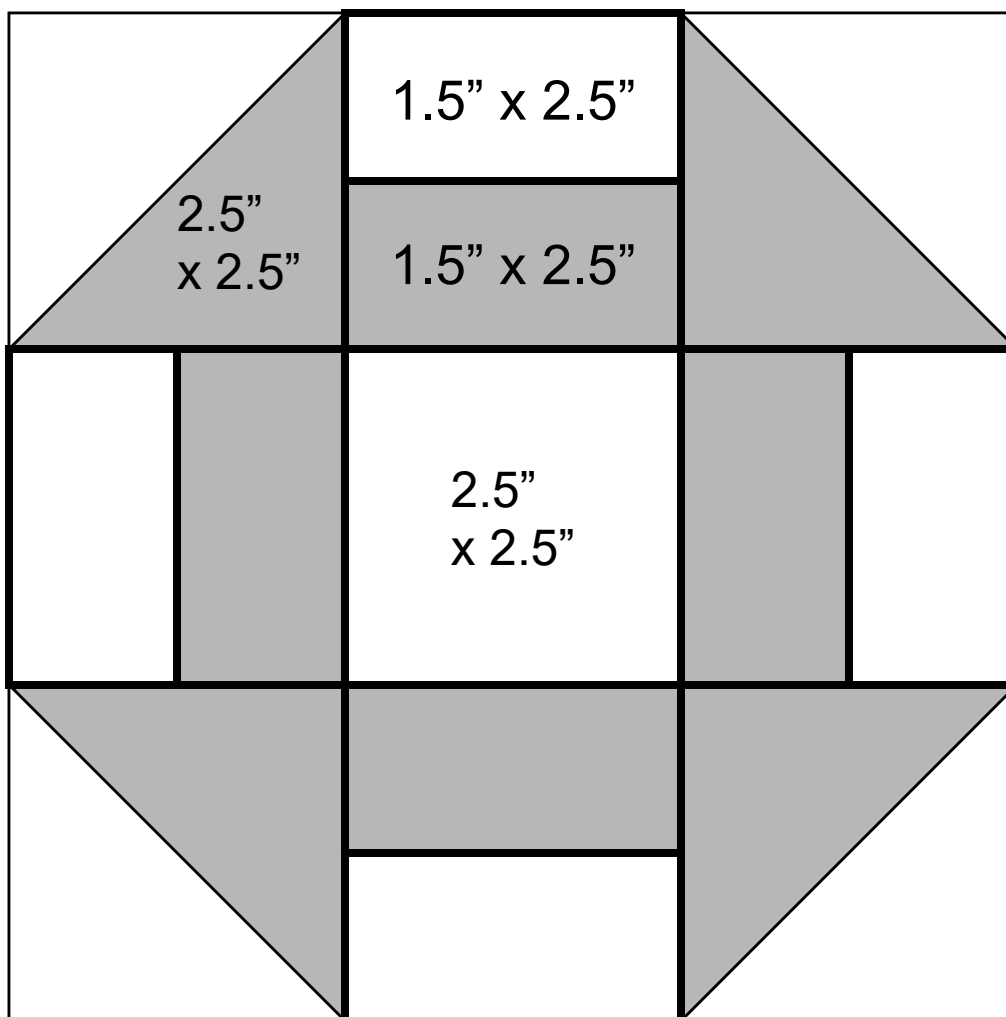

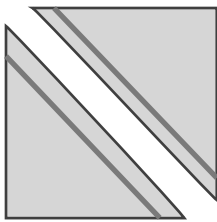
Step 1

- Draw a line on the back of all the lighter squares



Step 2

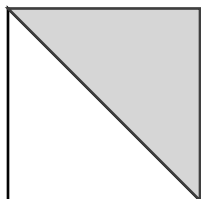
- Layer the 2 squares
- Sew a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam on both Sides of the drawn line



Step 3

Cut on the drawn Line for 2 HST

Step 4



-Trim squares to size needed using a square ruler with a diagonal line placed on the Seam.
