## 'OUT WEST!'

### **Cutting Directions**



- 1 Sandstone
  - 2 squares 4" x 4" for Half Square Triangles
  - 8 squares 3.5" x 3.5"



- **Deco Stitch** 
  - 2 squares 4" x 4" for Half Square Triangles
  - 4 squares 3.5" x 3.5"
  - 4 squares 2.5" x 2.5" for corners




10 Dance Steps

-4 squares 2" x 2"



16 Paisley
-4 strips 3.5" x 6.5"

### 'OUT WEST!'

#### **Directions**

1) Use the 4" Deco stitch & 4" sandstone squares Follow the HST method on last page. Make 4 units - trim to 3.5" square




2) Draw a diagonal line on the back of the All the 3.5" Deco stitch squares and 4 of the 3.5" sandstone squares Make 4 of each






- (3) Following the diagram
  - place a sandstone square on 3.5" x 6.5" paisley rectangle
  - Sew on the line.
  - Flip over and press, check the back to be sure it matches up to the rectangle
  - Trim away the excess corner fabric behind the triangle. Leave a 1/4" seam.
  - Make 4 Measures 3.5" x 6.5"




4) Follow the diagram use the 3.5" Deco stitch square, repeat step 3

Measures 3.5" x 6.5"








5) Following the diagram sew a 3.5" sandstone square, a HST, and the 3.5 x 6.5"

units together Make 4

Measures 6.5" x 6.5

### **Directions**

(6) Draw a diagonal line
On the back of each 2.5"
Deco Stitch square
Make 4




(8) Draw a diagonal line
On the back of each 2"
Dance Step square
Make 4




#### Step (7) Directions

- 1) Following the diagram, Place the 2.5" deco Stitch square on the sandstone corner
- 2) Sew on the line.
- 3) Flip over and press, check the back to be sure it matches up to the edges
- 4) Trim away the excess corner fabric behind the triangle. Leave a 1/4" seam.
- Make 4




#### Step (9) Directions

- 1) Following the diagram, Place the 2" dance step square on the split corner
- 2) Sew on the line.
- 3) Flip over and press
- 4) Trim away the excess corner fabric behind the triangle. Leave a 1/4" seam.
- 3) Make 4



10) Following the diagram sew the 4 units together Make 1

Measures 12.5" x 12.5



Block 12.5" x 12.5" Finished Size in the quilt is 12"








### **Half Square Triangles Tutorial**

NOTE- For other ways to make HST units, see my book "Pat Sloan's Teach Me to Sew Triangles"




Step 1

- Draw a line on the back of all the lighter squares



Step 2


- Layer the 2 squares
- Sew a ¼" seam on both Sides of the drawn line



Step 3

Cut on the drawn Line for 2 HST





-Trim squares to size in directions using a square ruler with a diagonal line placed on the Seam.
