## Cutting Directions



### 1 Sandstone

- 4 rectangles 2" x 3.5"
- 4 squares 2" x 2"



### 3 Just more Red

- 8 squares 3.5" x 3.5"



### 7 Teal ovals- MEW 36303

- 16 squares 2" x 2"



### 9 Tan Stars - env 61786

- 4 rectangles 3.5" x 6.5"
- 8 squares 2" x 2"



### 13 Painted Prairie

- 1 square 3.5" x 3.5"

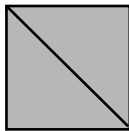

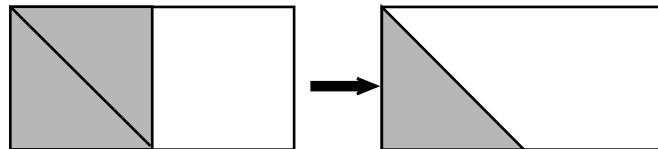
## Directions Flying Geese Units Aqua

- 1) Draw a diagonal line on each 2" Teal Oval square  
Make 8

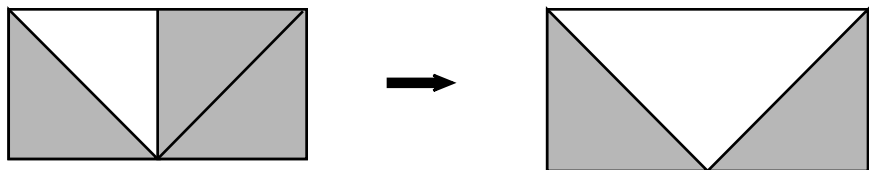


### Step (2)

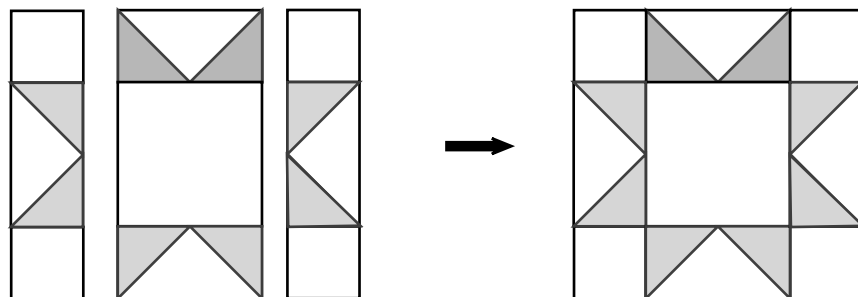
- 1) Following the diagram, Place a Teal oval square on 2" x 3.5" sandstone rectangle
- 2) Sew on the line.
- 3) Flip over and press, check the back to be sure it matches up to the rectangle
- 4) Trim away the excess corner fabric behind the triangle. Leave a 1/4" seam.
- 3) Make 4 Measures 2" x 3.5"



- 3) Following the diagram, repeat step 2 for the second square to make the flying geese  
Make 4  
Measures 2" x 3.5"



- 4) Following the diagram sew the star using 3.5" Prairie print, 4 sandstone squares 2", the 4 flying geese from above  
Make 4  
Measures 6.5" x 6.5"

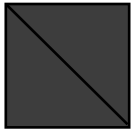

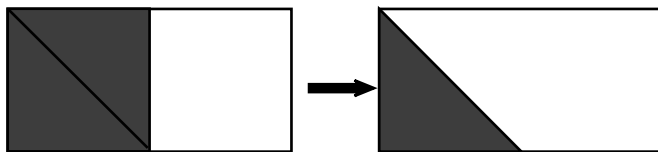
## Assemble Flying Geese Units black dot

- 5) Draw a diagonal line on each 3.5" red square  
Make 8



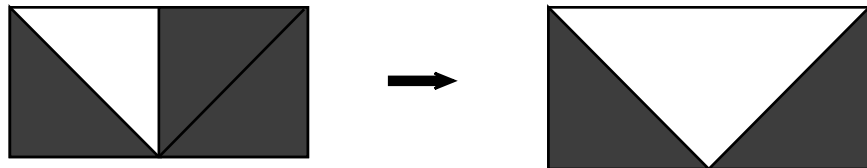
Step (6)

- 1) Following the diagram, Place a red square on 3.5" x 6.5" tan star rectangle
- 2) Sew on the line.
- 3) Flip over and press, check the back to be sure it matches up to the rectangle
- 4) Trim away the excess corner fabric behind the triangle. Leave a 1/4" seam.
- 3) Make 4 Measures 3.5" x 6.5"



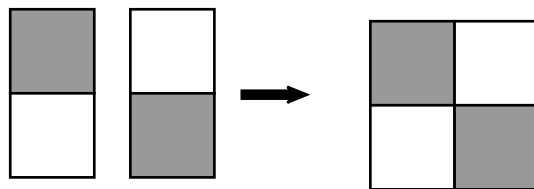
- 7) Following the diagram, repeat step 2 for the second square to make the flying geese  
Make 4

Measures 3.5" x 6.5"



- 9) Using 2 of the 2" tan star squares and 2 of the 2" teal squares make a 4-patch unit  
Make 4

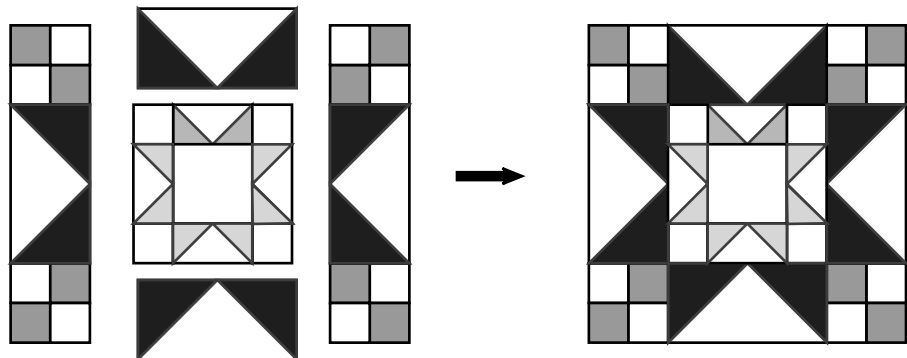
Measures 3.5" x 3.5"



- 9) Following the diagram assemble the block

Make 1

Measures 12.5" x 12.5"



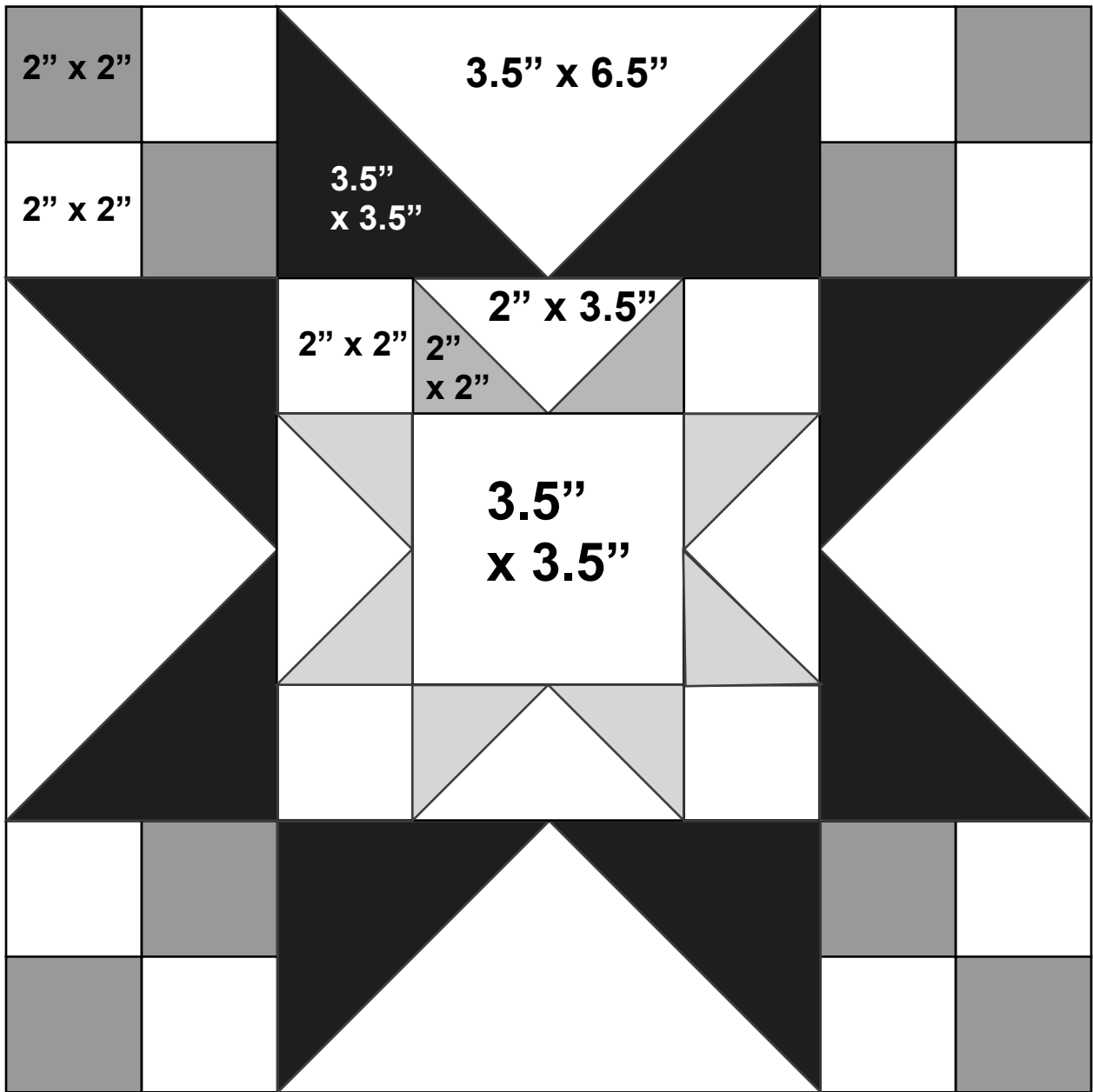
