

Supply List

1 - Stars in the Garden Panel 524E 1 yd - 531R Red (also binding) 1 1/4 yd - 533T Light Blue 1 yd - 525E Cream Floral

Cut from the Panel

Cut 4 piece "A" 6.5" x 6.5" Cut 4 piece "B" 3.5" x 3.5" Cut 1 piece "C" 9.5" x 9.5"

Cut from the Cream Floral

Cut 4 pieces 5.5" x 35.5"

Cut from the Light Blue

Cut 24 squares 4" x 4" for HST Cut 32 squares 3.5" x 3.5" Cut 8 strips 2" x 9.5"

Cut from the Red

Cut 24 squares 4" x 4" for HST Cut 4 squares 5.5" x 5.5" Cut 2 inner borders 1.5" x 33.5" Cut 2 inner borders 1.5" x 35.5"




How to Make Half Square Triangles

- Sewing Half Square Triangles Units (HST)

 1. Cut a light blue and red square 4" x 4". This method makes a slightly oversized block that you MUST trim to 3.5" square when done.
- 2. Each pair of light/dark squares makes TWO HST units.
- 3. Draw a diagonal line, as shown, on one square diagram (1).
- 4. Layer a light and a dark square with the right sides together.
- 5. Sew a seam 1/4" on each side of the drawn line (2).
- 6. Cut apart on the drawn line so you have two finished HST units (3).
- 7. Open each HST and iron to the darker side.
- 8. Trim the block to 3.5" x 3.5" with a square ruler. Align the diagonal on the ruler along the seam of the block (4).





Layer 2 squares right sides together Draw a line as shown on the fabric



Sew a 1/4" seam on either side of the drawn line







Cut apart on the drawn line




Make 4 Friendship Star Blocks

1.Following the diagram, Make 4 blocks. They will be 9.5" x 12.5"




Make 4 Large Star Blocks

1. Following the diagram, Make 4 large star blocks. They will be 12.5" x 12.5"



Assemble the Center

- 1.Top and bottom row Following the diagram, sew 2 large stars on either side of a Friendship star. Note the rotation of the Friendship star block.
- 2. Center Row Following the diagram, sew 2 friendship star blocks on either side of the birdhouse pane. Note the rotation of the Friendship star block.l



Add the Borders

- 1. Add the side inner borders to the center
- 2. Add the top and bottom inner borders to the center
- 3. Add 2 cream floral borders to the sides
- 4. Sew a red square to each end of the remaining cream borders.
- 5. Sew those borders to the quilt and your done!

BONUS Table Runner

Cut from the Panel


Cut 2 piece "A" 5.5" x3" Cut 1 piece "B" 8.5" x 6" Cut 2 patchwork borders 2" x 13" Cut 2 patchwork borders 2" x 26.5"

Cut from the Light Blue

Cut 2 strips 2.5" x 26.5" Cut 4 strips 2" x 5.5" Cut 4 strips 2.5" x 6"

Assemble the Runner

- 1. Following the diagram, sew a short blue to the top and bottom of each A.
- 2. Sew a medium blue to the sides of this unit
- 3. Make 2.
- 4. Sew Block A, Panel B, Block A.
- 5. Sew a long blue to the top and bottom
- 6. Sew long patchwork strips to the top and bottom
- 7. Sew short patchwork strips to the side.. done!
