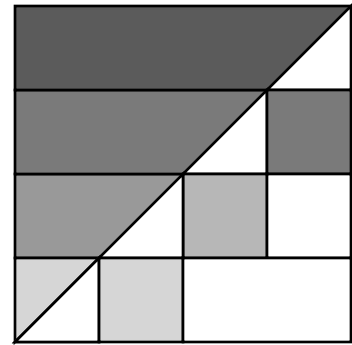
Block 11 – Something Sweet!

Cutting & Sewing

Background Fabric

- 1 square 4" x 4" for half square Triangle (HST)
- 4 squares 3.5" x 3.5"
- 1 rectangle 3.5" x 6.5"

Light Fabric

- 1 square 4" x 4" for half square Triangle (HST)
- Triangle (HST)
- Cut 1 square 3.5" x 3.5"

Medium light Fabrics

- Cut 1 square 3.5" x 3.5"
- Cut 1 rectangle 3.5" x 6.5"

Medium dark Fabrics

- Cut 1 square 3.5" x 3.5"
- Cut 1 rectangle 3.5" x 9.5"

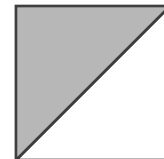
Dark Fabric

- Cut 1 rectangle 3.5" x 12.5"

Directions

1) Sew a light 4" square and a background 4" Square using the HST method on last page of this pattern

trim to 3.5" square
Makes 2 units
You will only use one

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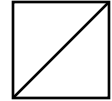

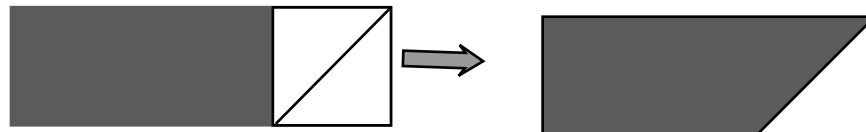
Directions

- 2) Draw a diagonal line on the back of 3 of the 3.5" x 3.5" background squares



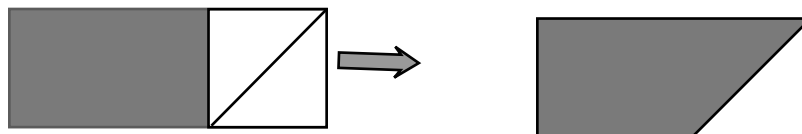
Step 3 Directions

- 1) Following the diagram, Place a 3.5" background square on the 3.5" x 12.5" dark rectangle
- 2) Sew on the line.
- 3) Flip over and press, check the back to be sure it matches up to the rectangle
- 4) Trim away the excess corner fabric behind the triangle. Leave a 1/4" seam.
- 3) Make 1 Measures 3.5" x 12.5"



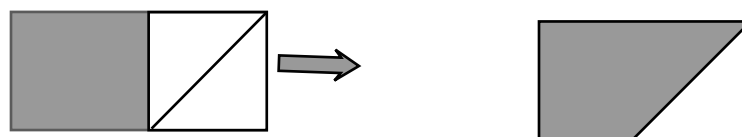
Step 4 Directions

- 1) Following the diagram, Place a 3.5" background square on the 3.5" x 9.5" Medium dark rectangle
- 2) Sew on the line.
- 3) Flip over and press, check the back to be sure it matches up to the rectangle
- 4) Trim away the excess corner fabric behind the triangle. Leave a 1/4" seam.
- 3) Make 1 Measures 3.5" x 9.5"



Step 5 Directions

- 1) Following the diagram, Place a 3.5" background square on the 3.5" x 6.5" Medium light rectangle
- 2) Sew on the line.
- 3) Flip over and press, check the back to be sure it matches up to the rectangle
- 4) Trim away the excess corner fabric behind the triangle. Leave a 1/4" seam.
- 3) Make 1 Measures 3.5" x 6.5"



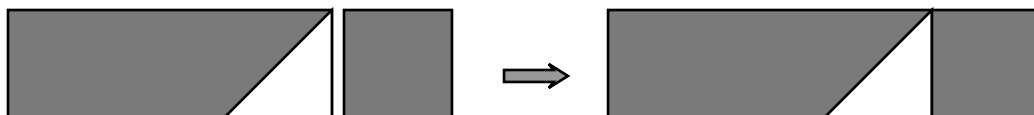
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Directions

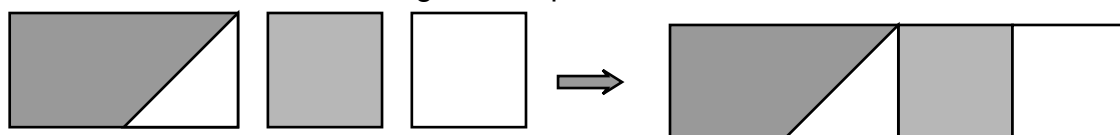
6) Following the diagram Sew a 3.5" medium dark square to the 3.5" x 9.5" medium dark Strip from above . Measures 3.5" x 12.5"

Make 1



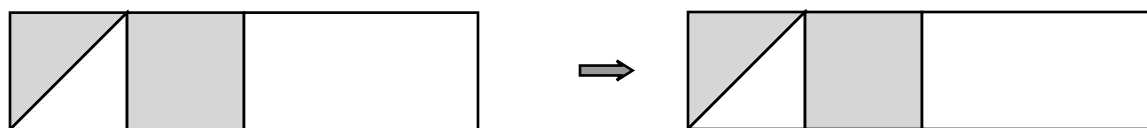
7) Following the diagram Sew a 3.5" medium light square to the 3.5" x 6.5" medium light Strip from above. Sew a 3.5" x 3.5" background square on the end Measures 3.5" x 12.5"

Make 1



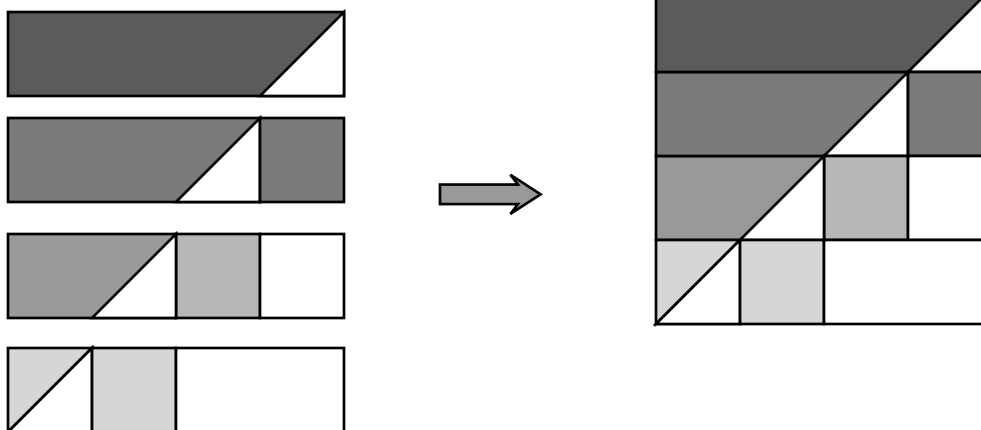
8) Following the diagram Sew the HST, a 3.5" light square and the 3.5" x 6.5" background Strip. Measures 3.5" x 12.5"

Make 1



9) Following the diagram sew the strips together Measures 12.5" x 12.5"

Make 1

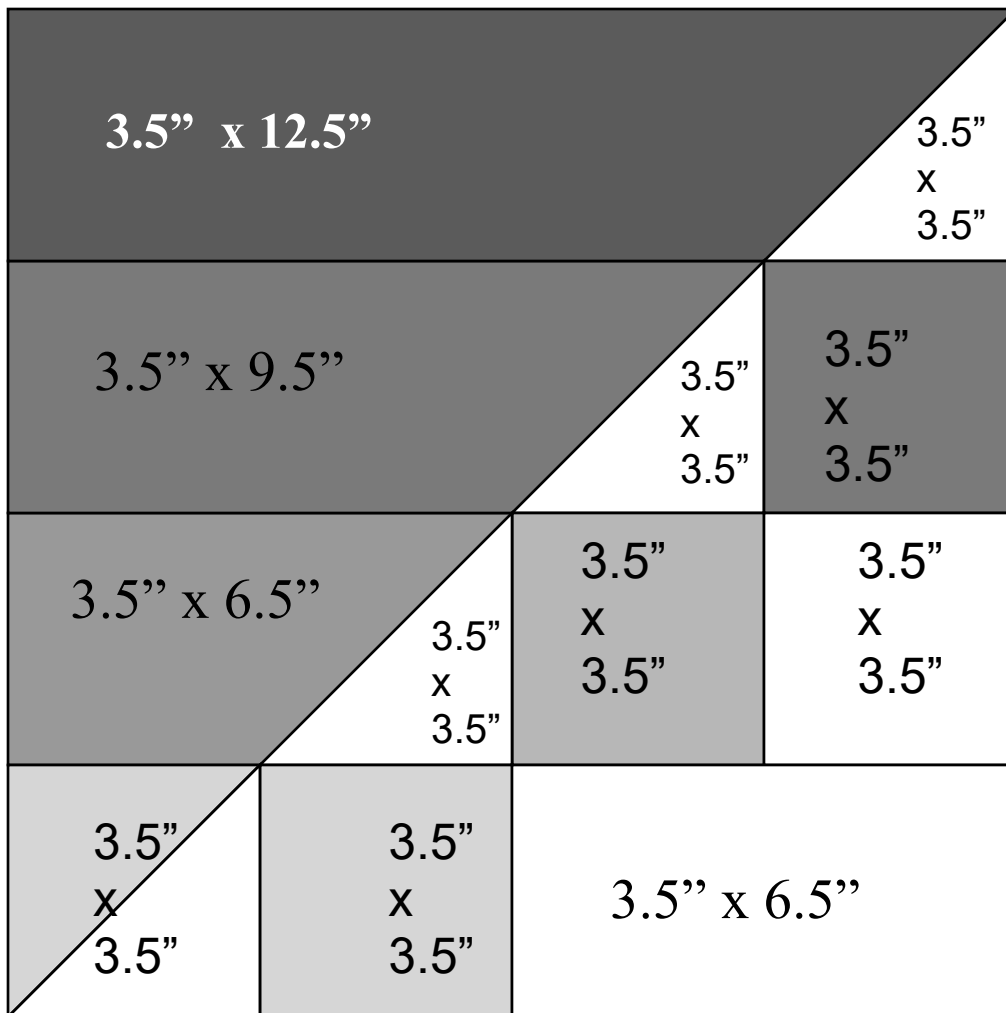

Block is 12.5" x 12.5"

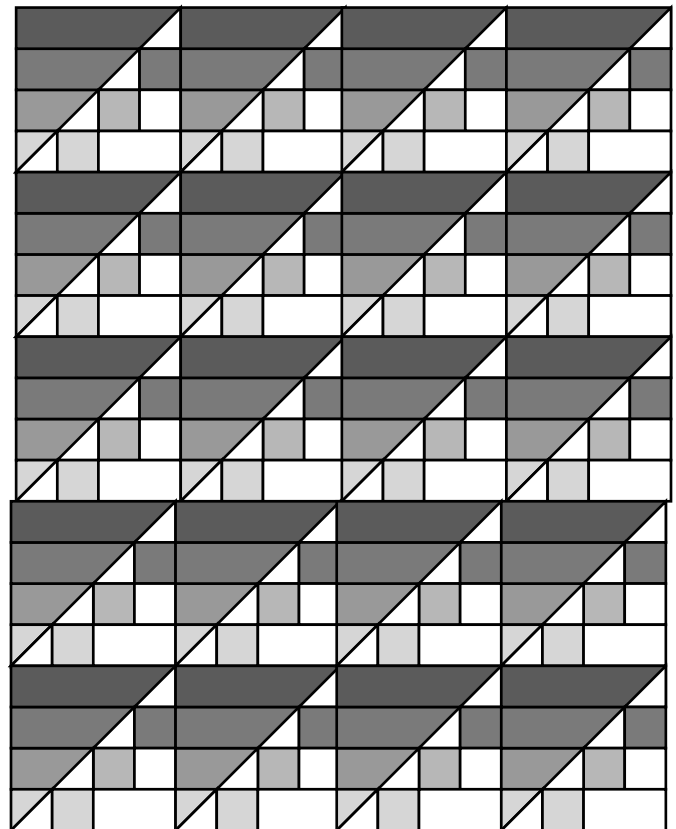
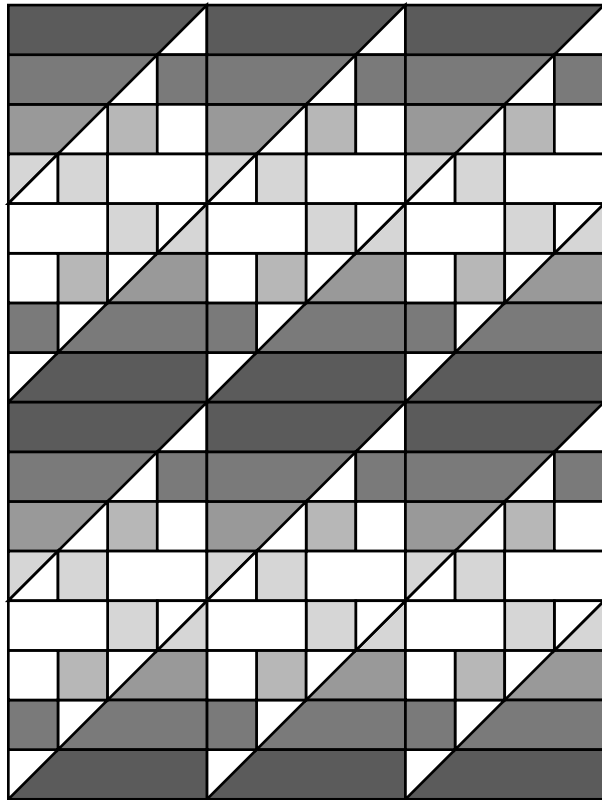
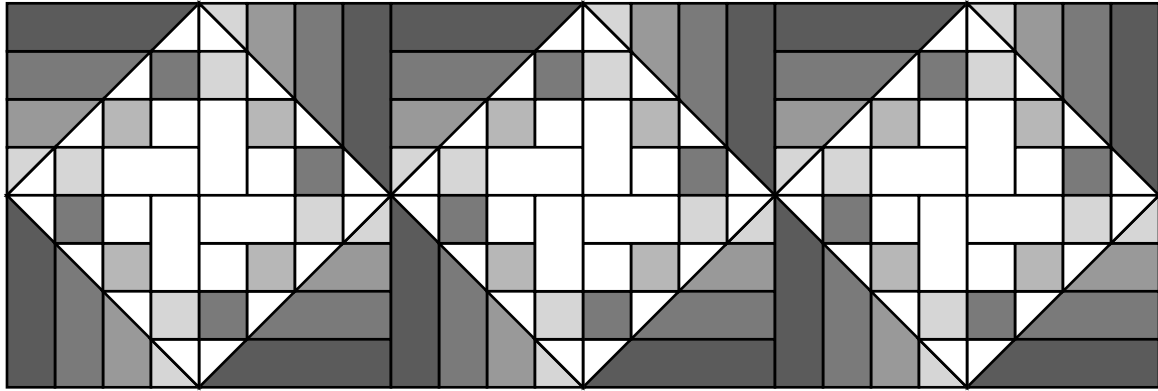
In the Quilt it is finished size 12" x 12"

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Half Square Triangles Tutorial

Step 1

- Draw a line on the back of all the lighter squares



Step 2

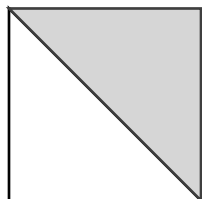
- Layer the 2 squares
- Sew a 1/4" seam on both Sides of the drawn line



Step 3

Cut on the drawn Line for 2 HST

Step 4



-Trim squares to size needed using a square ruler with a diagonal line placed on the Seam.
