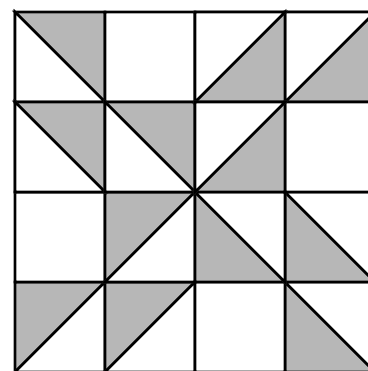

Cutting & Sewing 2 fabrics

Light Fabric

- you can use multiple fabrics

- Cut 6 squares 4" x 4" for HST (Half square Triangles)
- Cut 4 squares 3.5" x 3.5"

Medium Fabric

- you can use multiple fabrics

- Cut 6 squares 4" x 4" for HST (Half square Triangles)

OPTION 3 fabrics

Light Fabric

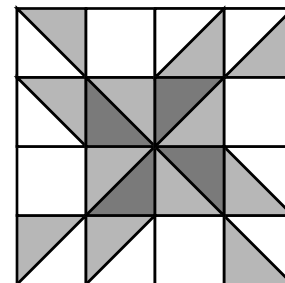
- Cut 4 squares 4" x 4" for HST (Half square Triangles)
- Cut 4 squares 3.5" x 3.5"

Medium Fabric

- Cut 6 squares 4" x 4" for HST (HST)

Dark Fabric

- Cut 2 squares 4" x 4" for HST (Half square Triangles)

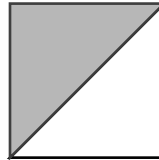

Directions

1) Sew a light 4" square and a medium 4" square using the HST method on last page.

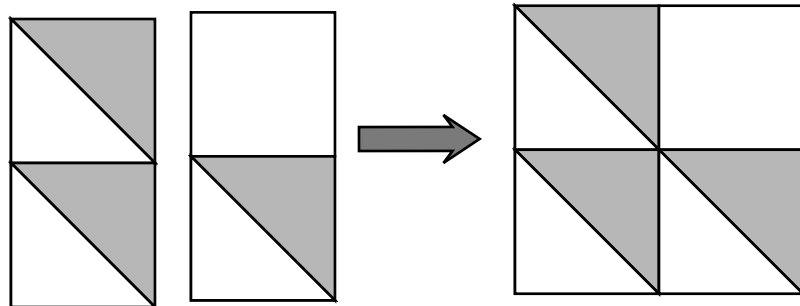
trim to 3.5" square
Make 12 units



2) Following the diagram sew together 3 HST block and 1 light square

Measures 6.5" x 6.5"

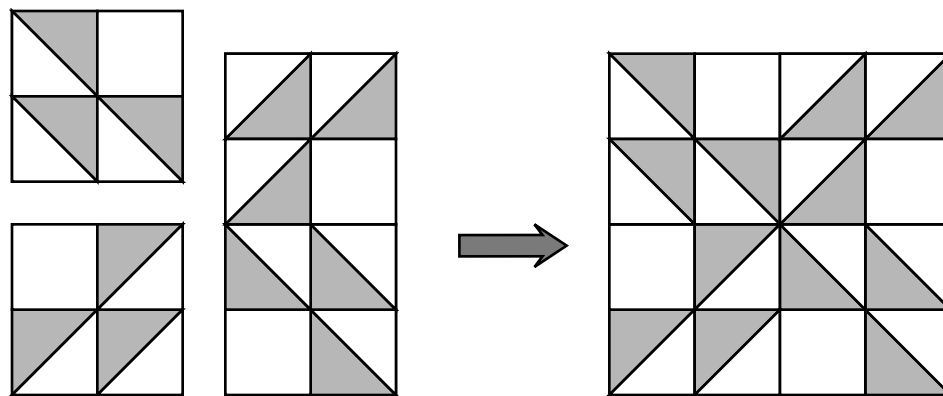
Make 4



3) Following the diagram, sew the 4 units from above, be aware of the position of each unit

Measures to 12.5" x 12.5"

Make 1

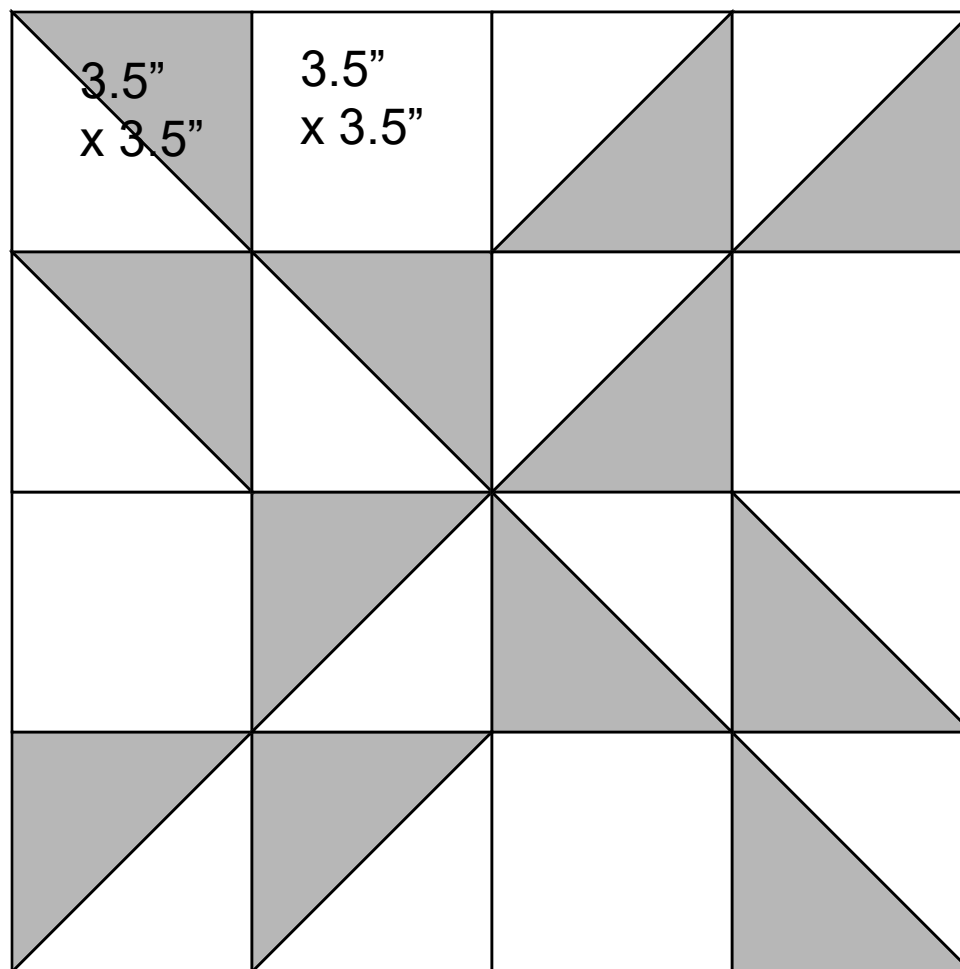

In the Quilt it is finished size 12" x 12"

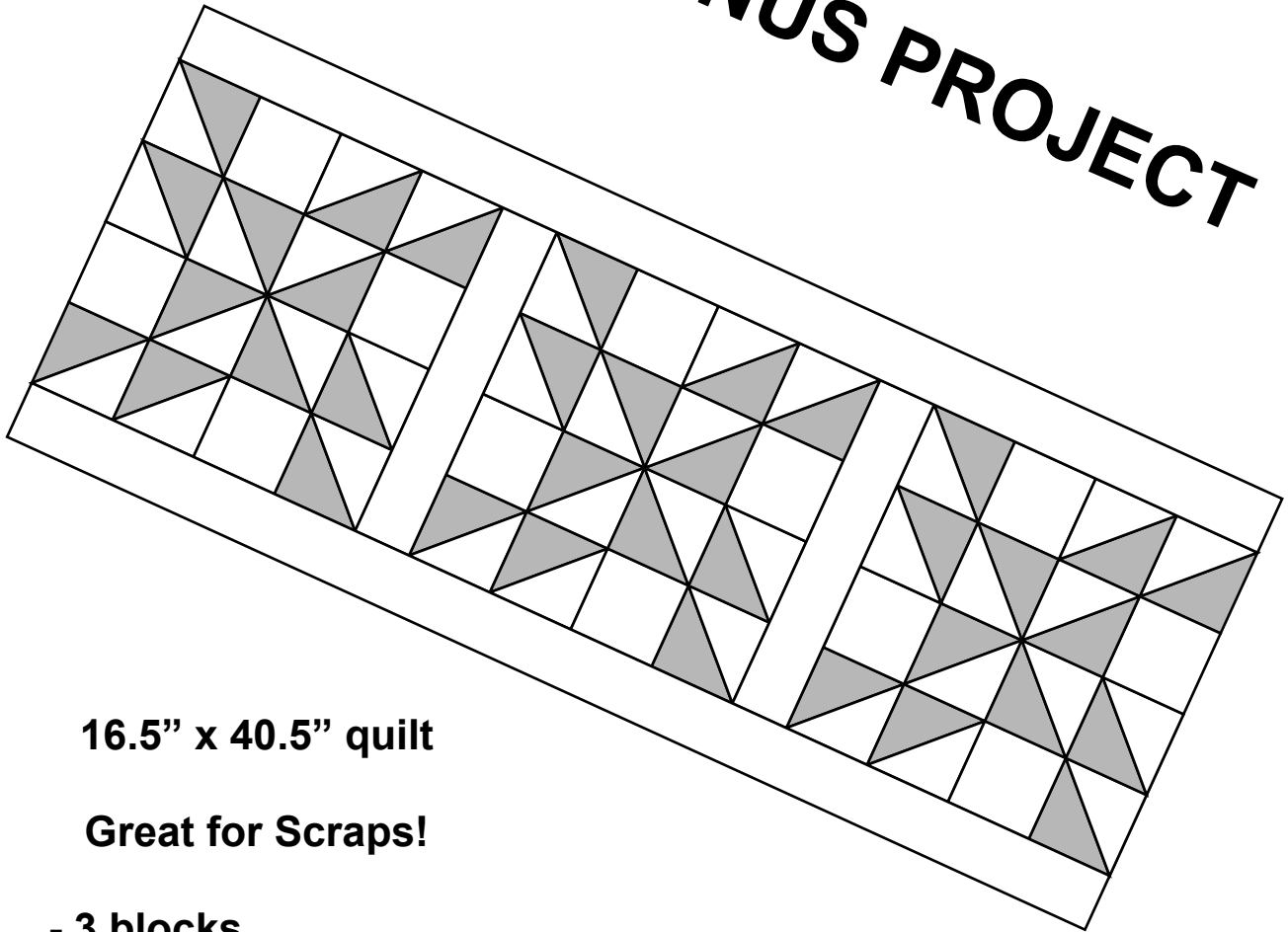

Great for Scraps!

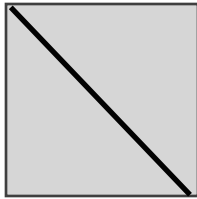
- 3 blocks
- 2 strips 2.5" x 12.5"
- 2 strips 2.5" x 40.5"

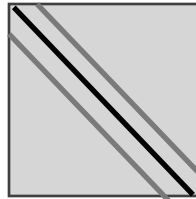
Half Square Triangles Tutorial

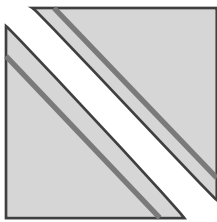
Step 1

- Draw a line on the back of all the lighter squares



Step 2

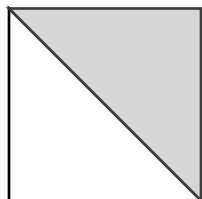
- Layer the 2 squares
- Sew a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam on both Sides of the drawn line



Step 3

Cut on the drawn Line for 2 HST

Step 4



-Trim squares to size needed using a square ruler with a diagonal line placed on the Seam.
