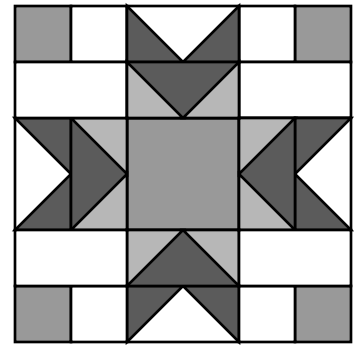

Cutting & Sewing

Background Fabric

- 4 squares 2.5" x 2.5"
- 8 rectangles 2.5" x 4.5"

Light Fabric

- Cut 8 squares 2.5" x 2.5"

Medium Fabrics

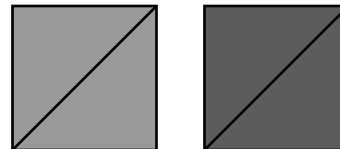
- Cut 1 squares 4.5" x 4.5"
- Cut 4 squares 2.5" x 2.5"

Dark Fabric

- 8 squares 2.5" x 2.5"
- 4 rectangles 2.5" x 4.5"

Directions

- 1) Draw a diagonal line on the back of all the
 - 2.5" x 2.5" Light squares
 - 2.5" x 2.5" Dark squares

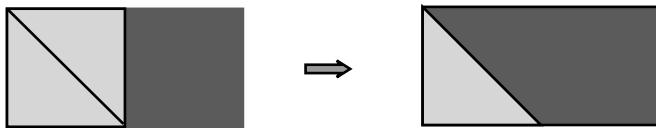

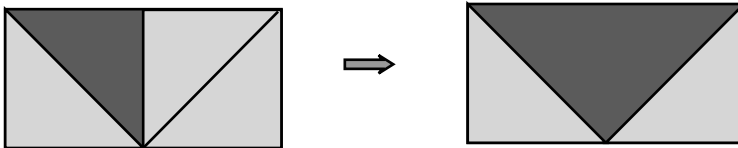
Step 2 Directions

- 1) Following the diagram, Place a 2.5" light square on the 2.5" x 4.5" dark rectangle
- 2) Sew on the line.
- 3) Flip over and press, check the back to be sure it matches up to the rectangle
- 4) Trim away the excess corner fabric behind the triangle. Leave a 1/4" seam.
- 3) Make 4 Measures 2.5" x 4.5"



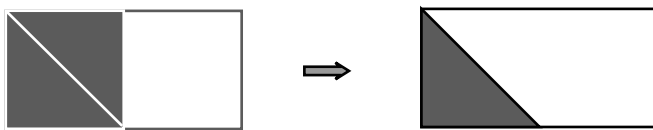
Step 3 Directions

- 1) Following the diagram, repeat step 2 for the second square to make the flying geese
- 2) Make 4



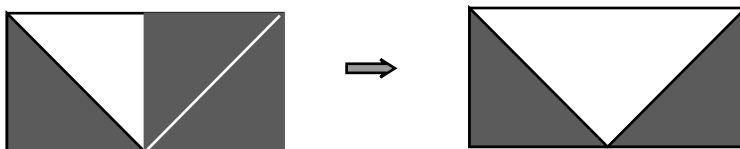
Step 4 Directions

- 1) Following the diagram, Place a 2.5" dark square on the 2.5" x 4.5" background rectangle
- 2) Sew on the line.
- 3) Flip over and press, check the back to be sure it matches up to the rectangle
- 4) Trim away the excess corner fabric behind the triangle. Leave a 1/4" seam.
- 3) Make 4 Measures 2.5" x 4.5"



Step 5 Directions

- 1) Following the diagram, repeat step 2 for the second square to make the flying geese
- 2) Make 4

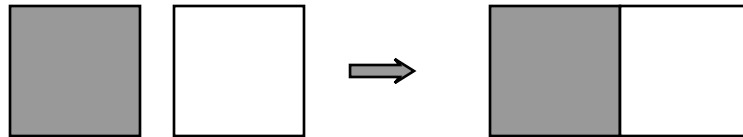

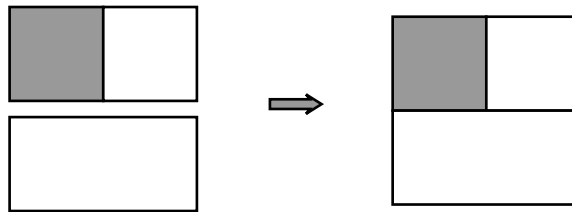

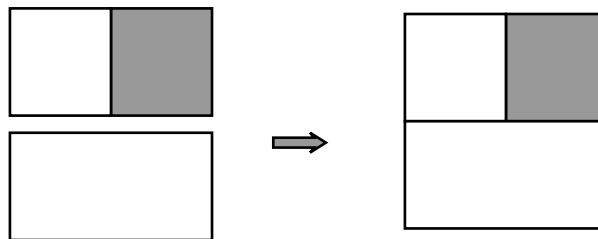
6) Following the diagram Sew a 2.5" medium square to a 2.5" background square
Measures 2.5" x 4.5"
Make 4



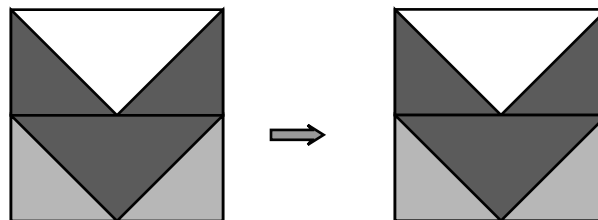
7) Following the diagram Sew a 2.5" x 4.5" background rectangle and a unit from above.
Measures 4.5" x 4.5"
Make 2



8) Following the diagram Sew a 2.5" x 4.5" background rectangle and a unit from above.
Measures 4.5" x 4.5"
Make 2



9) Following the diagram Sew a background 2.5" x 4.5" unit and a dark background unit from earlier steps together
Measures 4.5" x 4.5"
Make 4

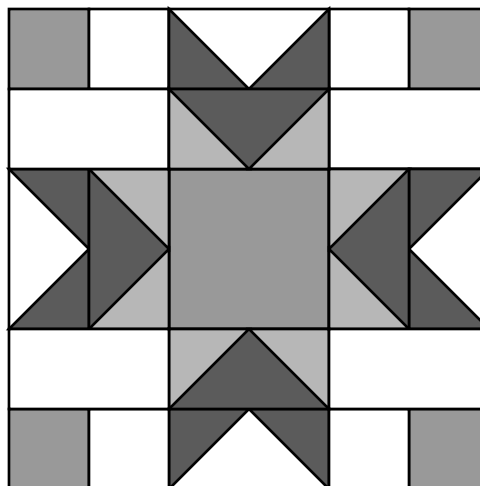
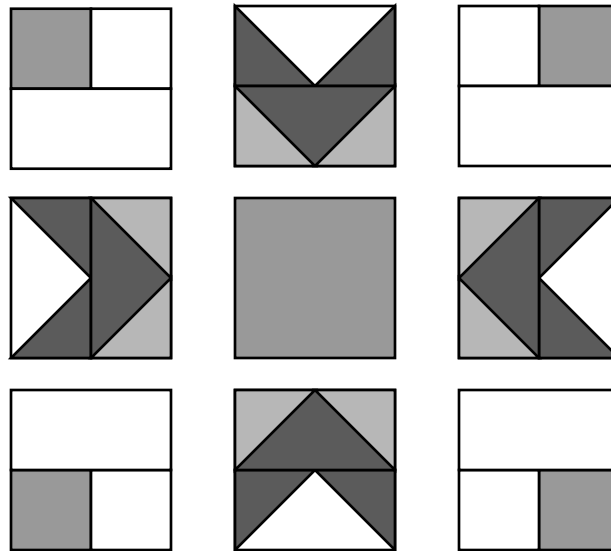

Make 1

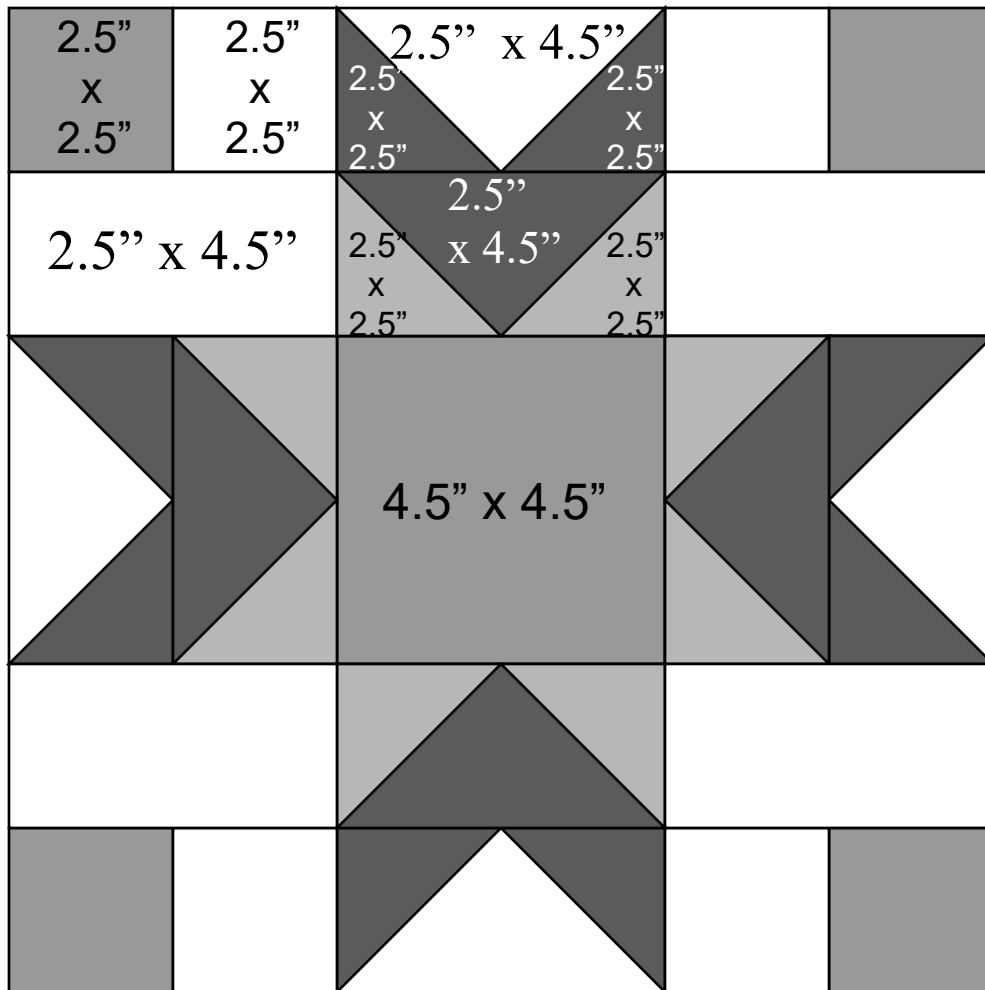

Block is 12.5" x 12.5"

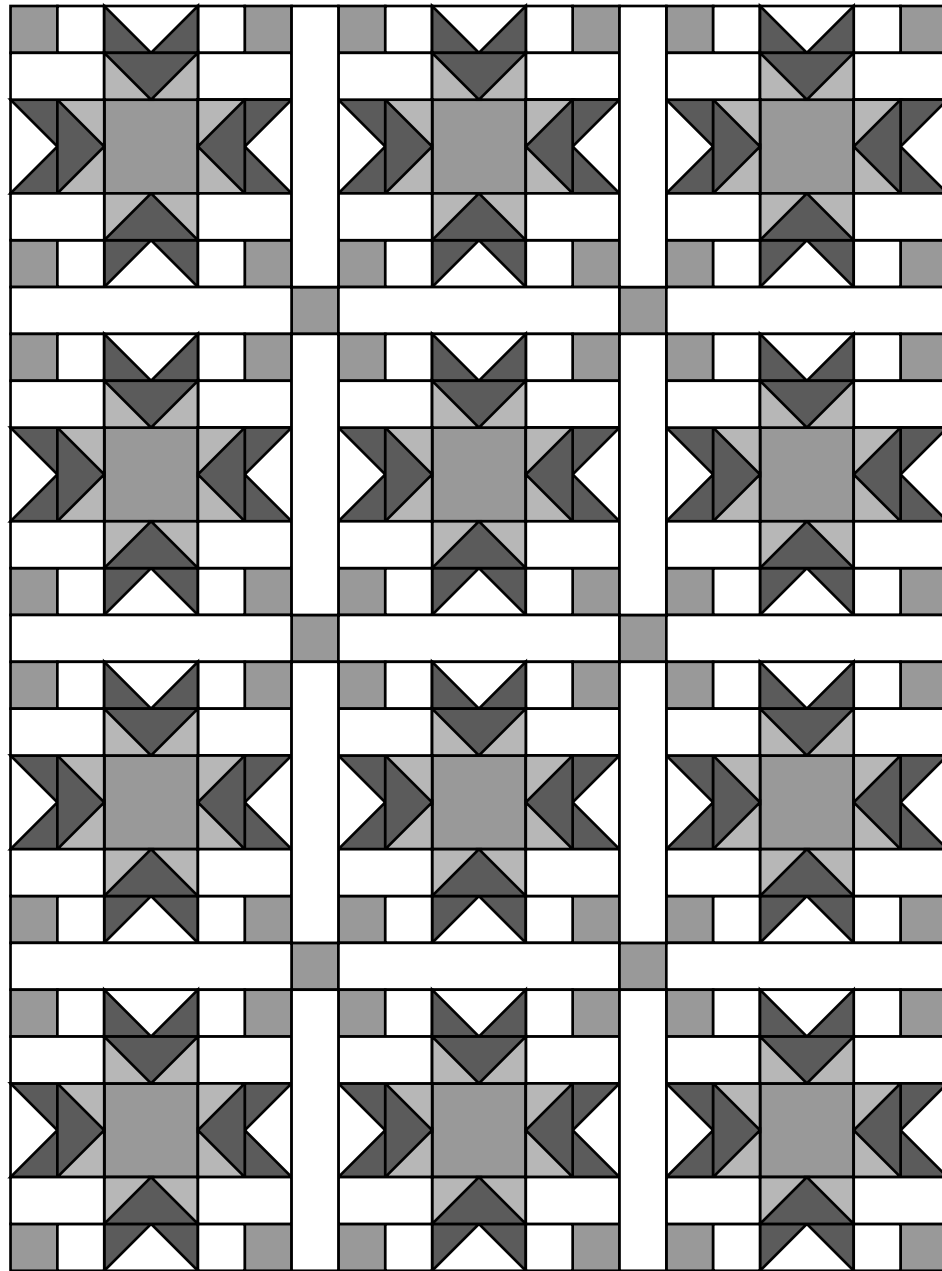
In the Quilt it is finished size 12" x 12"

40.5" x 54.5" quilt

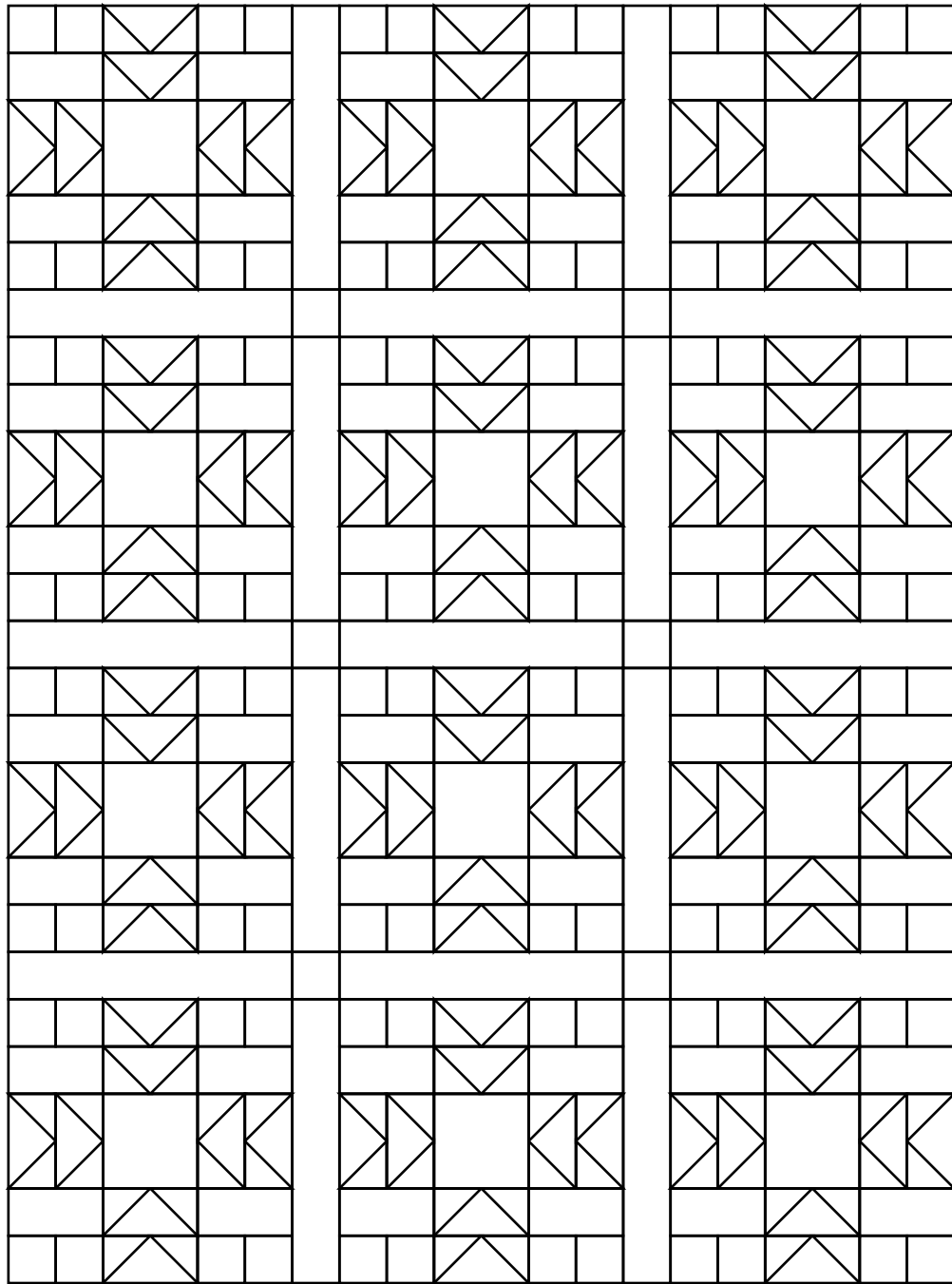
- 12 blocks
