Cutting & Sewing

Light Fabric

- Cut 4 squares 3" x 3" for HST (Half square Triangles)
- Cut 4 rectangles 2.5" x 4.5"
- Cut 4 squares 2.5" x 2.5"

Medium Fabric

- Cut 2 squares 3" x 3" for HST (Half square Triangles)
- Cut 8 squares 2.5" x 2.5"

Dark Fabric

- Cut 2 squares 3" x 3" for HST (Half square Triangles)
- Cut 8 squares 2.5" x 2.5"

TIP - you can use multiple Fabrics

Directions

1) Sew a light 3" square and a medium 3" Square using the HST method on last page. trim to 2.5" square

Make 4 units



2) Sew a light 3" square and a dark 3" Square using the HST method on last page. trim to 2.5" square Make 4 units



3) Following the diagram sew the center 16-patch block using 8 of the dark 2.5" squares and 8 of the medium 2.5" squares

Measures 8.5" x 8.5"

Make 1



4) Following the diagram sew a medium and a dark HST unit together"

Measures 2.5" x 4.5"

Make 2







5) Following the diagram sew a medium and a dark HST unit together"

Measures 2.5" x 4.5"

Make 2








6) Following the diagram, sew the light squares, light rectangles, HSTs, and 16-patch block from above

Measures to 12.5" x 12.5"

Make 1


Step 1

- Draw a line on the back of all the lighter squares



Step 2


- Layer the 2 squares
- Sew a ¼" seam on both Sides of the drawn line



Step 3

Cut on the drawn Line for 2 HST

Step 4



-Trim squares to size needed using a square ruler with a diagonal line placed on the Seam.
