- 2) Fine Point Sharpie
- 3) Machine or hand embroider
- 4) Some people also have success with Ink jet printers

Information to Write

- 1) Name of the quilt or the Pattern name
- 2) Name of the Pattern Designer
- 3) Your name as the maker not grandma but your real name so they know 'which grandma' years later
- 4) Who you are giving it to
- 5) Date finished
- 6) Celebration date if it applies, anniversary, birth, Marriage, retirement, vacation dates.
- 7) Name of anyone else that helped make it
- 8) Name of the longarm quilter
- 9) Where you live, city/state
- 10) If shipping it, put your email and phone number.
